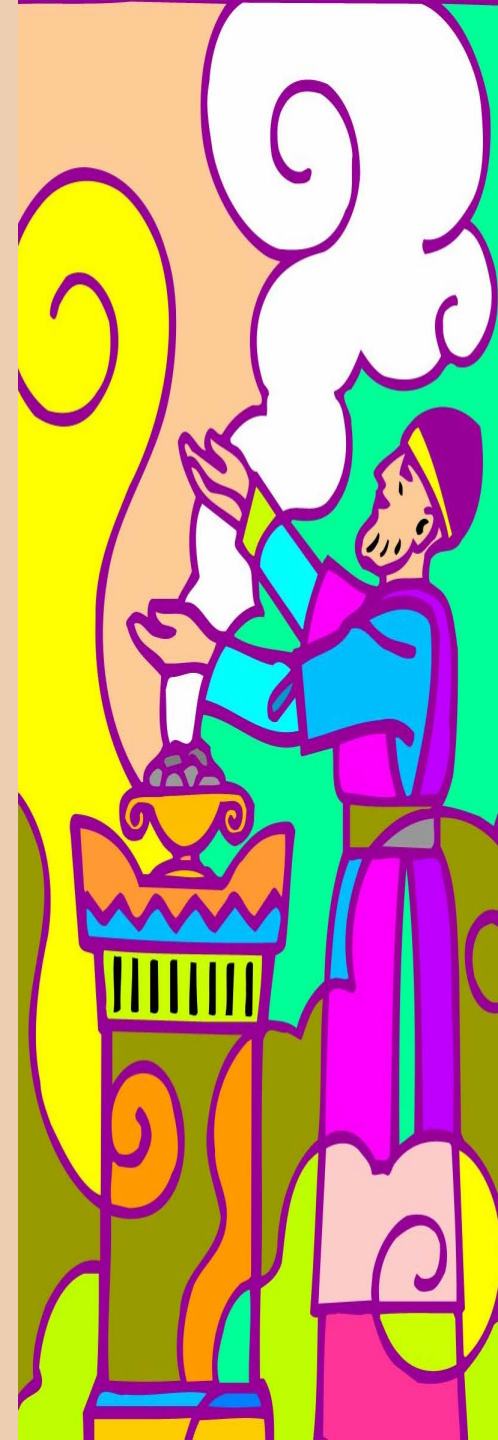

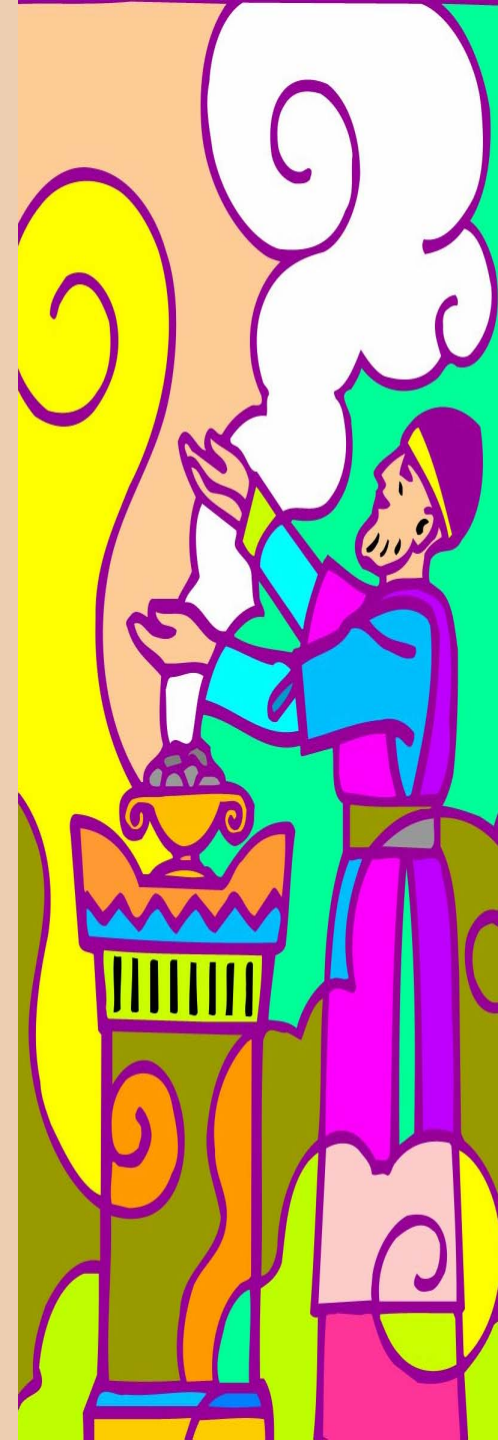

WORSHIP FROM ADAM TO AARON

God took the **initiative** in providing a way for man to worship Him.



How can a sinful man worship God?

1. Look at Genesis 3:21,
Who took the initiative ?
And what did God do?
2. Look at Hebrews 9:22,
Why do you think God
killed animals to clothe
Adam and Eve?



How can a sinful man worship God?

1. God made garments for Adam and Eve.
2. “without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness”

These garments suggest that an animal was sacrifice, and this sacrifice symbolically spoke of atonement—the covering of sin by the blood of God’s chosen sacrifice. Jesus, the Lamb of God, who not only covers our sin but takes away our sins (John 1:29)



Worshipping God's way?

1. Read Genesis 4:2-5,
Why do you think God accepted Abel's offering but didn't accept Cain's.
2. Look at Hebrews 11:4,
What do you learn there about the basis of Abel's offering?



Worshipping God's way?

God did not accept Cain's offerings, why?

- Wrong offering, or
- Acceptable offering but wrong attitude, or
- Wrong offering combined with wrong attitude.

Abel offered a better sacrifice than Cain.

- By faith,(trust God)
- He was righteous .

Not all worship is acceptable to God.
We must worship Him in His way,
not our own.



Worship and Obedience

1. What do you learn about Noah in Genesis 6:22 & 7:5?
2. What does Genesis 8:20-21 add to your understanding of Noah's worship?
3. In Genesis 22:5, What does Abraham tell his servants he plans to do on the mountain?



Worship and Obedience

1. Noah did **all** God commanded him to do.
2. He had a concern for what was acceptable to God. **“clean”**
3. When Abraham laid Isaac on the altar, he intended to sacrifice **all** that God had promised him.



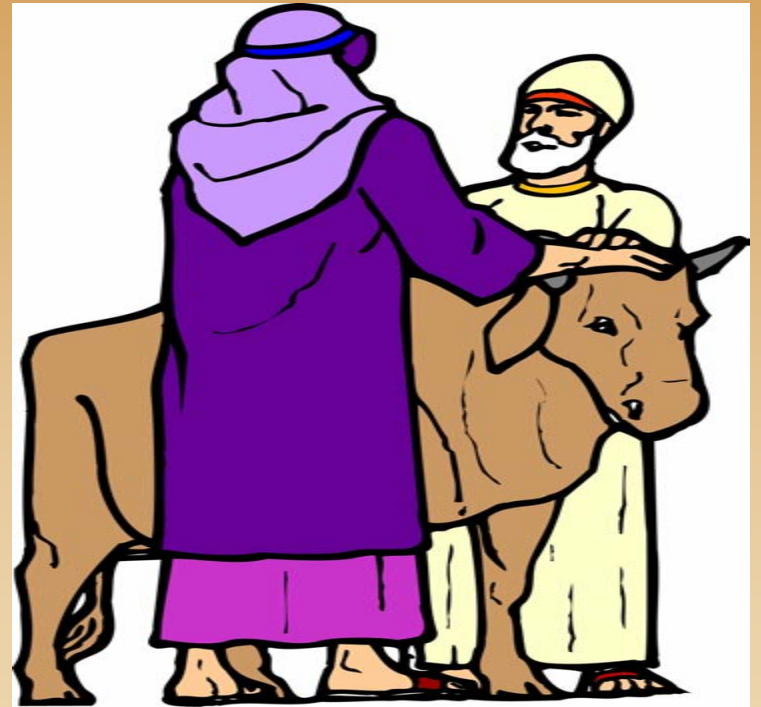
The response of a grateful heart.

1. What motivated Abraham to worship God?

Genesis 12:1-8

2. What motivated Moses to worship God?

Exodus 3:12



The response of a grateful heart.

Abraham worshipped God when God spoke to him and when God did not abandon His kindness and faithfulness to him.

Moses worshipped God after God delivered Israel from Egypt, after God heard their groaning from Egypt, after God's deliverance through the Passover, after God's deliverance of Israel from the Amalekites and at the giving of the law.



How can a sinful man worship God?

The wrong way to deal with sin.

Hide and Blame.

The right way to deal with sin.

Repent and Confess.

**Sin must be dealt with if
worship is to happen.**

Worship is more than an emotion, more than an experience, more than a service- it is connecting with our Creator.

But King David replied to Araunah, “No, I insist on paying the full price. I will not take for the Lord what is yours, or sacrifice a burnt offering that costs me nothing.” 1 chronicles 21:24

**“I urge you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.”
Romans 12:1**

Noah and Abraham, there can be **no worship without obedience.**

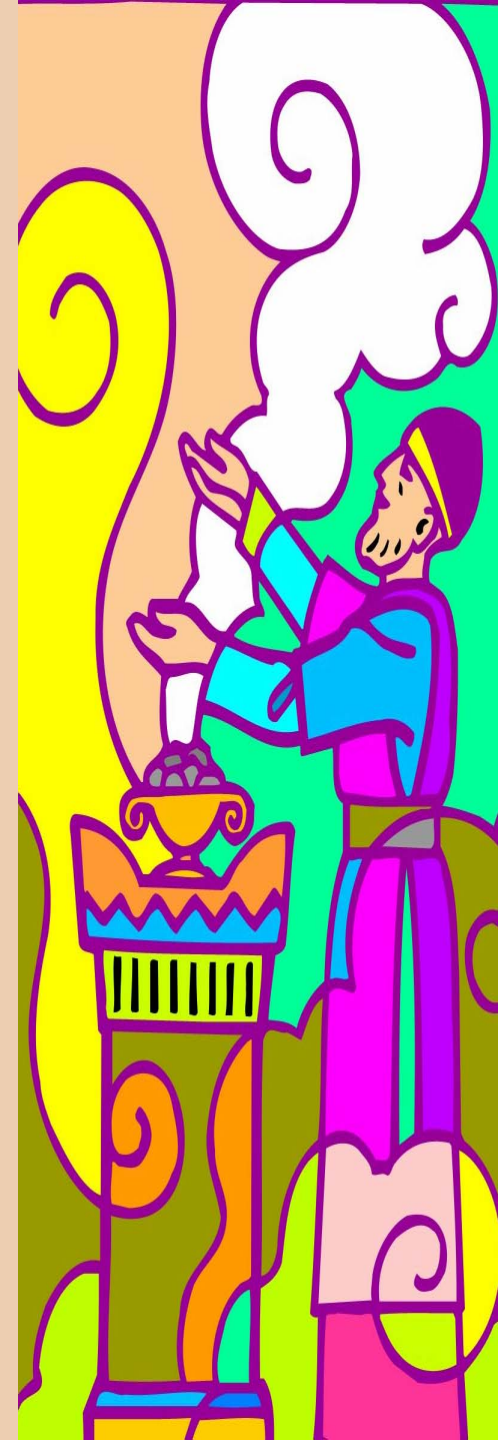
Abraham and Moses, **worship is the response of a grateful heart.**
