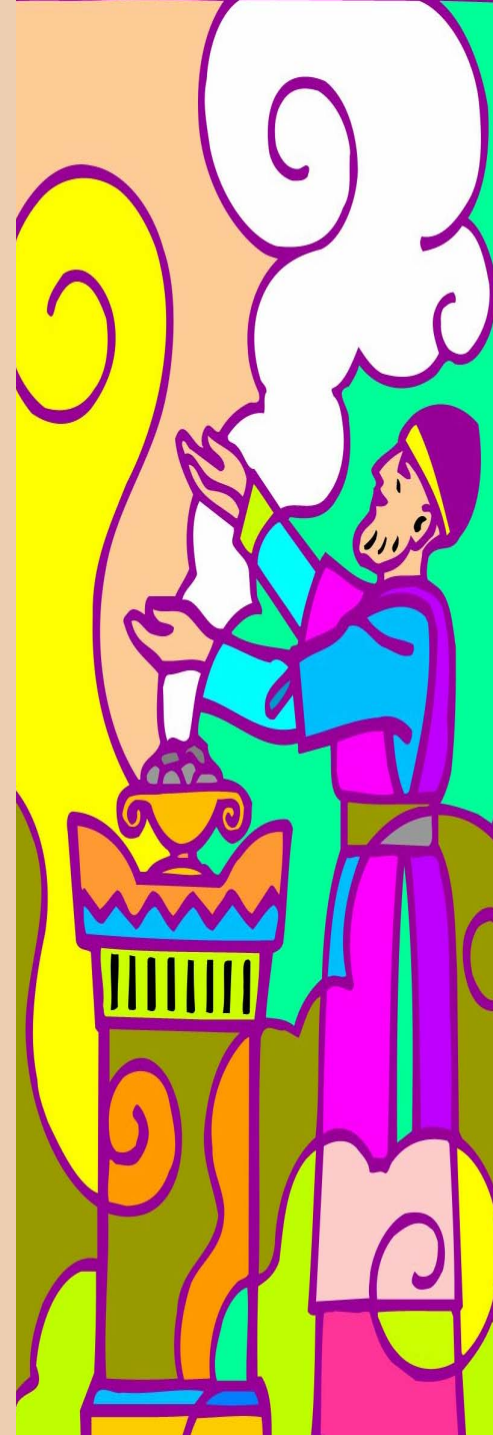

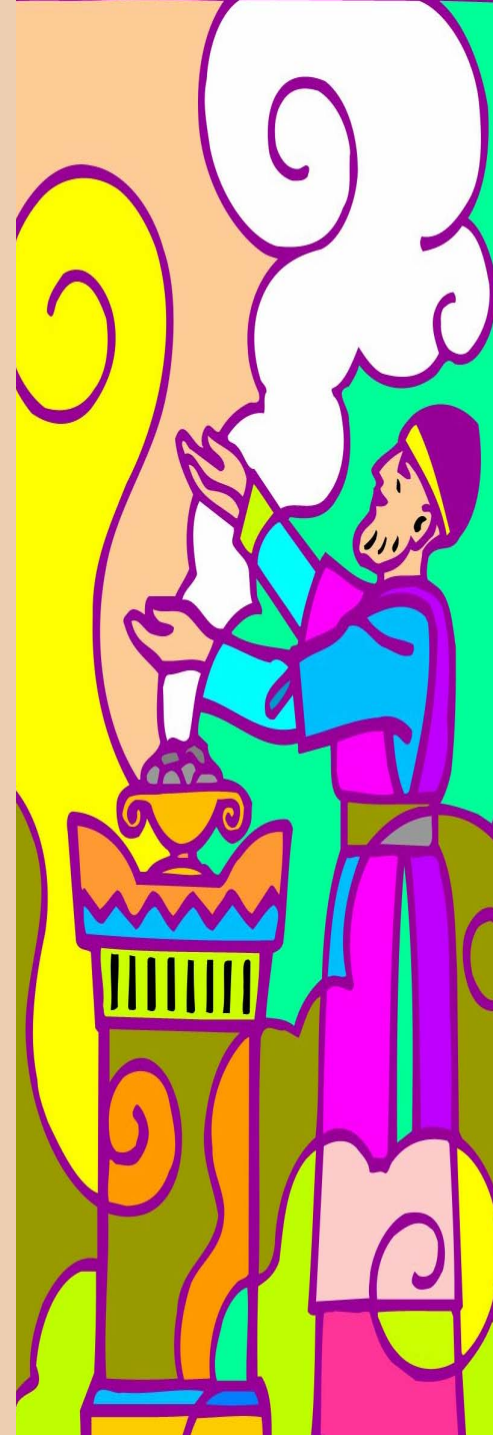

True worship flows from the heart of one who walks in the fear of the Lord, who withholds nothing from God.



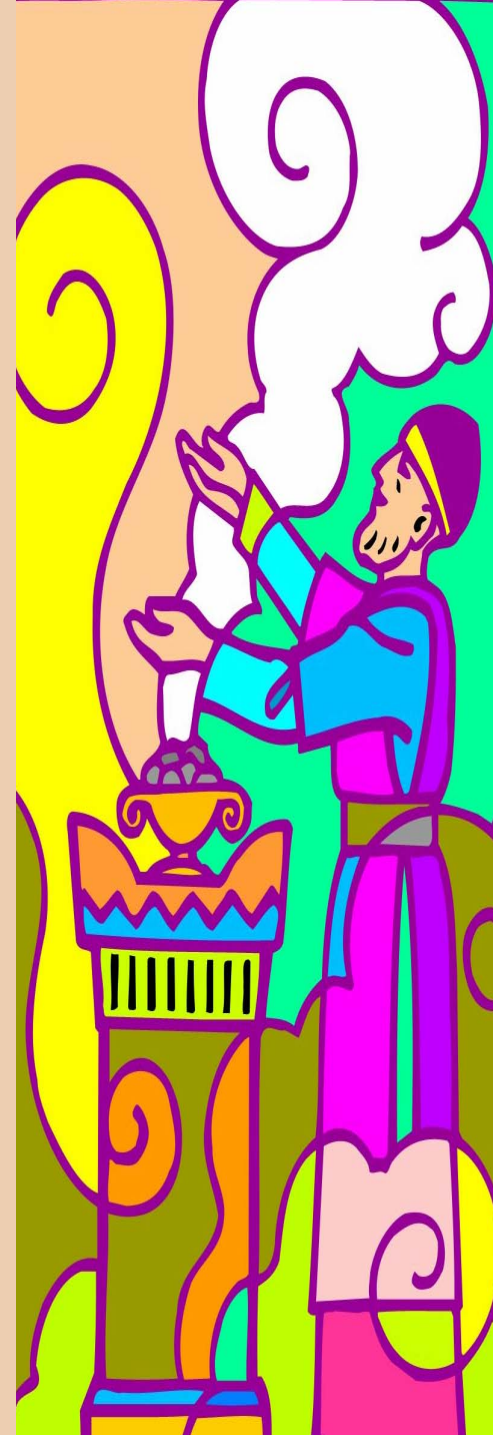

Who is Jesus?

1. Son of God
2. Heir of all things
3. Radiance of God's glory
4. Exact representation
5. Greater than the angels
6. Sovereign Lord
7. God
8. His throne is forever
9. His scepter is a righteous scepter
10. Firstborn

The work of Jesus.

1. Creator of the heavens and the earth.
2. Came as the God-Man
3. Died on the cross
4. Made purification for our sins
5. Arose from the dead
6. Ascended through the heavens
7. Finished the work the Father gave him to do
8. Now sits at the right hand of God.

What are called and commanded to do?

1. Pay close attention to all that Jesus has said and all He has done.
2. As we listened and follow Him, we will not drift into neglect in our walk or into unbelief in our relationship with Him.

1. What do you discover about Jesus?
2. What did He faced as a man, and what does it mean to us?
3. What we do you find about our High Priest?

Our Sympathetic High Priest

1. Made a little lower than the angels
2. Taste death for everyone
3. Bringing many sons glory
4. Experience suffering in becoming the mature man.
5. Now crowned with glory and honor.

What Jesus face as a man?

1. He is flesh and blood like us in every area.
2. Feelings, physical needs, weariness and temptations of a man.
3. Jesus knew about the sins men faced from a man's perspective and from God's perspective.
4. He died as a merciful and faithful High Priest.

What do you find about our high priest?

“For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weakness, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.” Hebrews 4:15

Our Sacrificial High Priest

1. What was the benefit of the OT sacrifices in taking away sin?
2. How did Christ view the OT sacrifices?
3. What was the result of the sacrifice of Christ?
4. How can we “draw near” to God?

What was the benefit of the OT sacrifices in taking away sin?

1. No cleansing to the worshipper
2. No removal of his sins
3. Only remind one of sins year after year.

How did Christ view the OT Sacrifices?

- ▶ Christ knew that none of the sacrifices of the OT could take away sins.
- ▶ Jesus knew His body was prepared to be that sacrifice; that was His Father's will, and He willingly went to the cross as that sacrifice.

What was the result of the sacrifice of Christ?

1. We have been cleansed and set apart.
2. Continually set apart and increasing in maturity.
3. The Holy Spirit leads us in what is right,
4. All our sins are forgiven and forgotten
5. Open the way for us to live in His presence

Three Commands, “Let us

1. Draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith,.....
2. Hold fast the confession of our hope...
3. Consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together,.....

Our Strong High Priest

1. How Abraham & Moses practice their faith, and what did they endure?
2. How the men and woman endured in running their race?
3. God is able...

“go from strength to strength”

Abraham

- left his country
- left the culture
- Look for the fulfillment of all the promises God made to him.

Moses

- opportunity to live in the influence and power..
- choose instead to endure hardship...
- His endurance came through “seeing Him who is unseen,”

Three commands, " Let us.....

1. Lay aside every weight...
2. Lay aside the sin....
3. Run with endurance...
4. "fixing our eyes on Jesus,"

God is able.....

- ▶ Aid those who are tempted
- ▶ To discern the thoughts and intents of the heart
- ▶ To save us completely
- ▶ To keep you from stumbling
- ▶ To do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in you,
