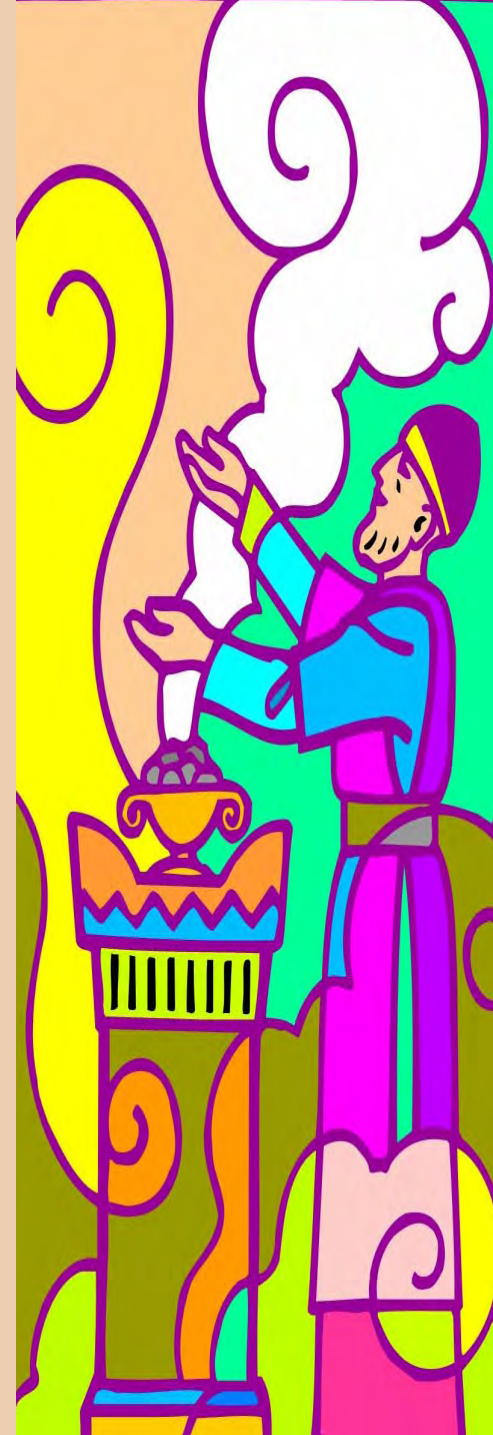

Cain and Abel, we must worship God in His way, with the right method and the right motive.

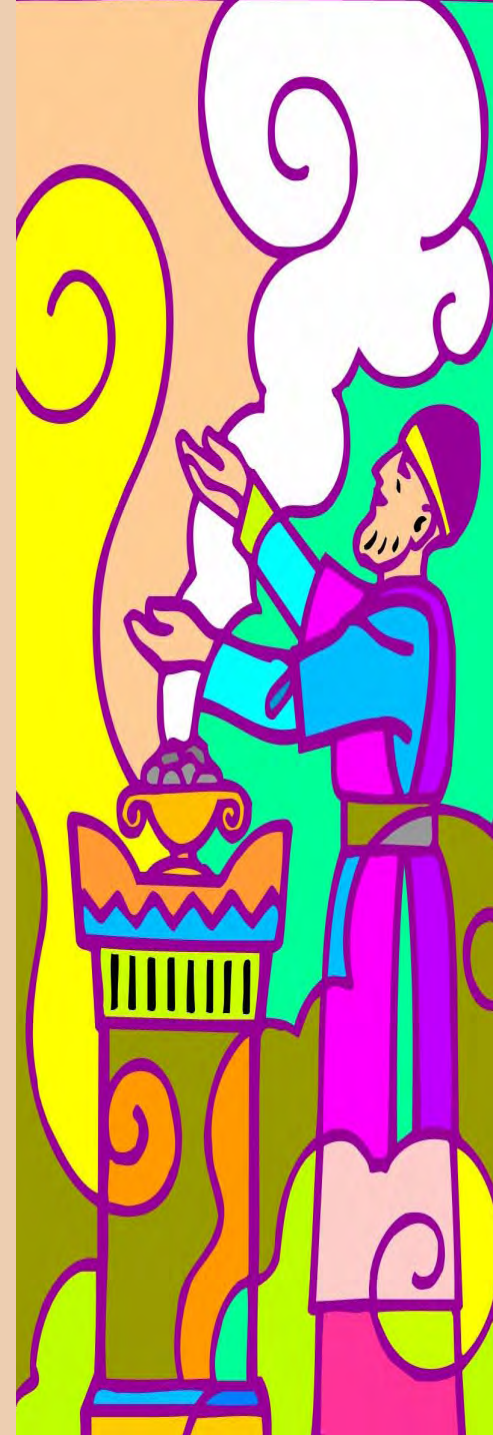
Noah and Abraham, there can be no worship without obedience.

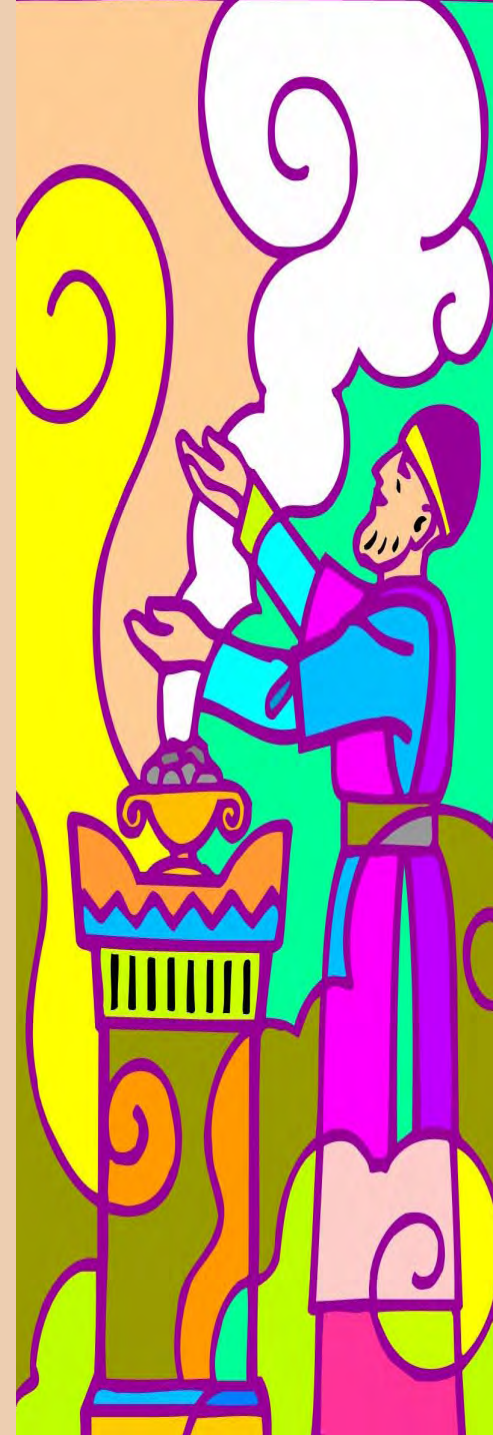

Each place of worship was a place of an altar—a place to deal with sin and express surrender to the Lord.

It was a place of “calling on the name of the Lord”



“Called upon the name of the Lord”

1. El Elyon (God most high)
2. Shield and Reward
(Protector and Provider)
3. YHWH Yireh
(The Lord provides)



God definition of worship

- “now I know that you fear God”
- “you have not withheld your son, your only son from me”
- “you have obeyed my voice”

Place of Meeting

1. “holy ground” (“set apart”)
2. “mountain of God”
3. Tabernacle



“Called upon the name of the Lord”

1. I AM who I AM
2. The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, the God of Jacob.
3. Jehovah-Ropheka:
The Lord who heals you.
4. Jehovah-Nissi:
The Lord is my Banner.

470 years: From Moses to David

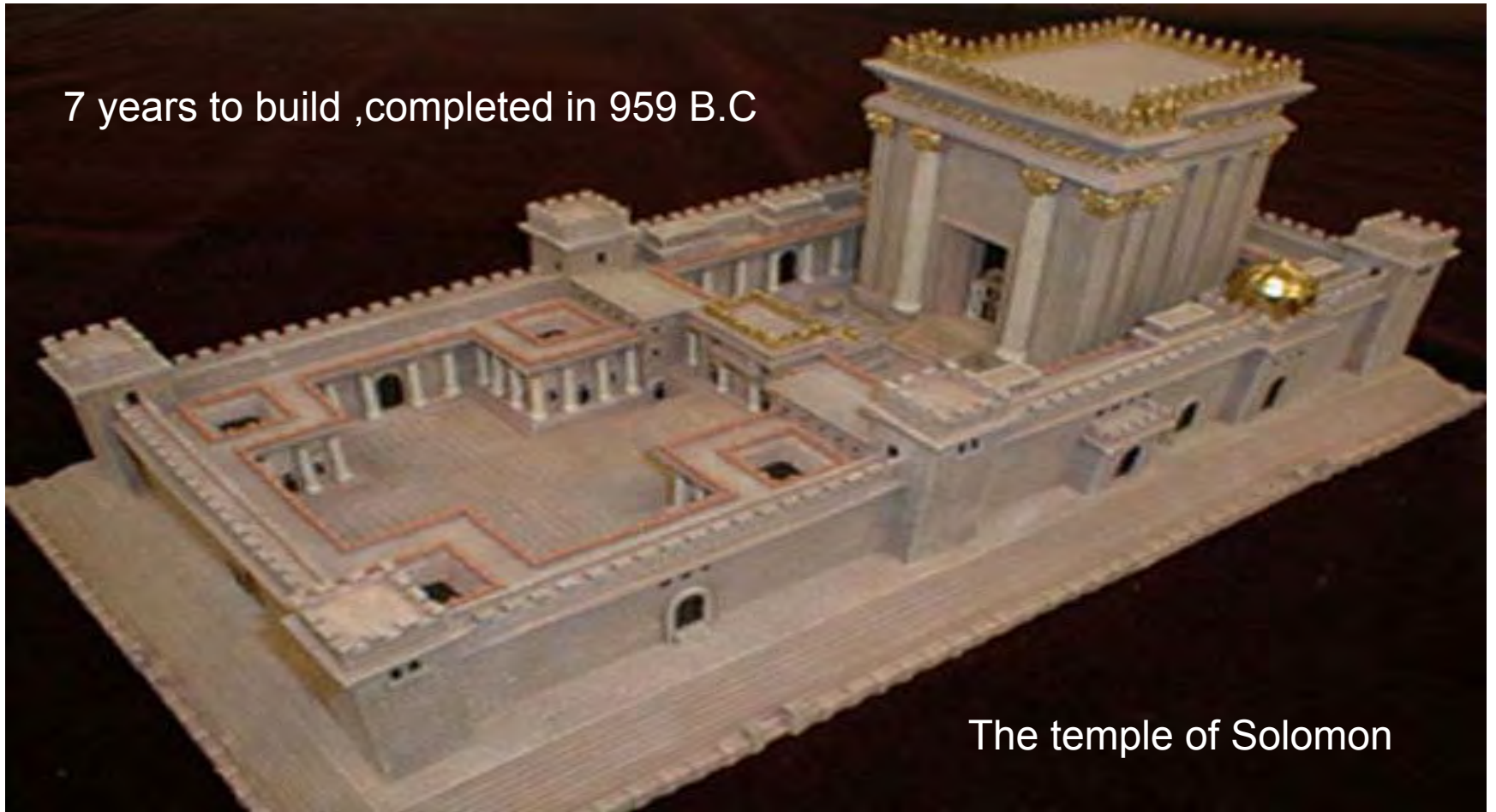
Fire was over it by night

God with us-

The temple and Jesus

1. Then “the house of the Lord was filled with a cloud”-the Shekinah Glory cloud of the Lord’s presence.
2. The Lord revealed Himself in fire-”fire came down from heaven and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices”



God with us-

The temple and Jesus

1. Read John 2:13-22.
What did Jesus say about the temple?
2. Then read John 1:14 . Who Jesus is and what He did.



God with us-

The temple and Jesus

1. They had turned the temple, the meeting place for the worship of God, into a market place.
2. Jesus, the eternal Word, the Creator of the world, became flesh and “tabernacle” in a divinely human body.



God in us-

2. Read 1 Corinthians 6:19-20. What did Paul tell these Christian about their walk with God?



God in Us-

The Work of the Holy Spirit in His Temple

1. “tongues of fire”
rested on each of
the disciples and
“they were filled
with the Holy Spirit”
2. “Your body is the
temple of the Holy
Spirit who is in you,
whom you have
from God..”



God comes to meet with us

In each meeting place, we see the Lord truly revealing Himself and his people responding with worship.

Each place of worship was a place of an altar-a place to deal with sin and express surrender to the Lord.

It was a place of “calling on the name of the Lord” and gratefully acknowledging His provision.



God dwells with us-

Moses and the tabernacle

God revealed Himself in His glory with a visible cloud covering the tent. The place of the cloud of glory /pillar of fire was a place of unconditional surrender. When God moved, the people moved. Where and when God stayed, the people stayed. Worship always involves submission, surrender, and service to the One you worship.



God with us-

The temple and Jesus

The Temple was a place of prayer, a place of fellowship with the Lord of heaven and the earth as well as a place to find forgiveness of sins.

Jesus was God dwelling with us in the divine tabernacle of His body. By His presence, the glory of God was manifested as at the Tabernacle and at the temple. He revealed the fullness of God as no one else had ever done.



God in us-

The work of the Holy Spirit in His temple

The Tabernacle and Temple give a clear, accurate, and good opinion about the living God. This is also what He has designed each of His disciples to do. A Christian's daily walk should reflect how God would act in any place or situation.



Where We Meet God

God comes to meet us.

A place (Altar) to deal with sin and to call on the name of the Lord

God dwells with us.

A place (Tabernacle) of the cloud of glory / pillar of fire was a place of unconditional surrender.

God with us.

A place (Temple) of prayer, fellowship with the Lord and to find forgiveness of sins.

God in us.

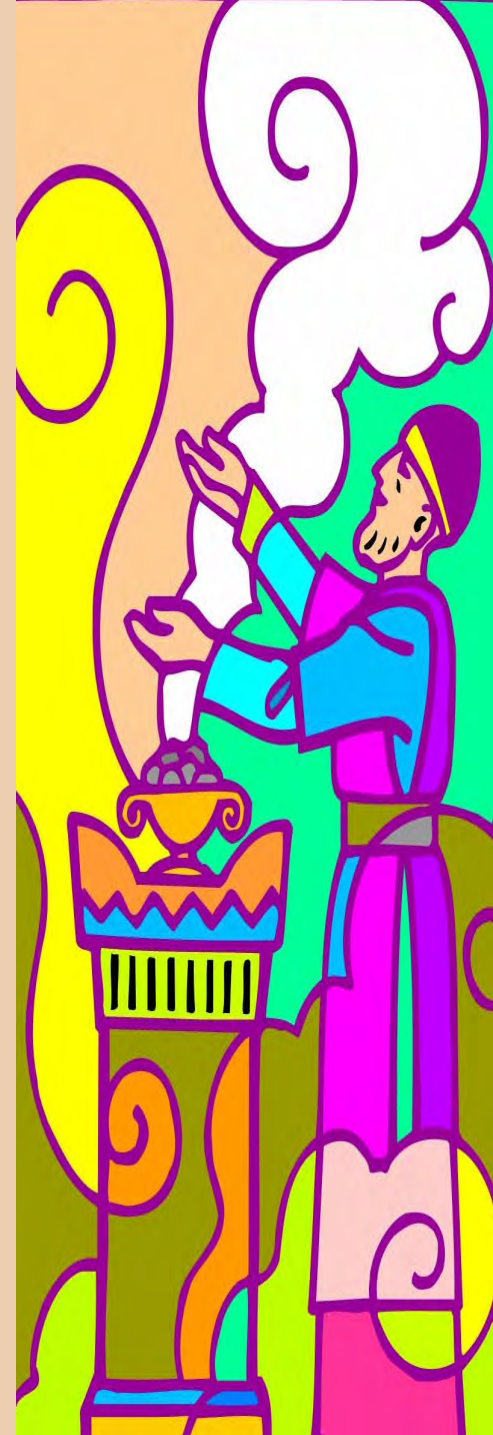
A place (Christian) that gives a clear, accurate and good opinion of the living God.
