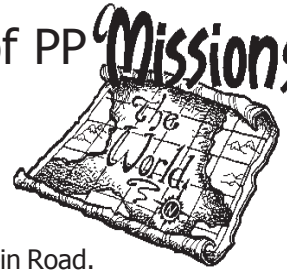

7 Milestones of PP Missions

As we look forward to Missions Sunday on the 19th of October, let us look back at the significance of the 7 milestones of PP Missions.

7 Milestones of PP Missions



Milestone #1: In 1968, PP made weekly mission trips to Johor Baru, cooperating with the church at Moulmein Road.

A house was rented at Century Gardens with brother Lau Kin Fatt as the first weekend missionary.

Milestone #2: PP joined hands with brother Winston Bolt to plant the first congregation in Batam. This work in turn has grown to establish many congregations in Indonesia.

Milestone #3: The Pence Dacuses joined PP's first mission team to Kuching, East Malaysia led by our minister. This spurred the church into a passion for tentmaking trips.

Milestone #4: Deacon KC and brother Patrick, together with brother Tony Yeung and the Dacuses conducted the first of the annual China seminars in 2000.

Milestone #5: The House Helpers BC initiated the work in Tuao, Philippines. With the direction of deacon Winston and others, our youth were thrown into missions work.

Milestone #6: PP-SIBI discipleship programme for our youth starting soon.

Milestone #7: PP sends elder Eric Tan as our first full-time missionary to China in January 2009.
