Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Two weeks ago I was informed that the our account in the States was minus five dollars at the end of June. This means that funds to pay the school expenses in the month of July are not available. The July budget is our most expensive (\$7250.00) as we pay for all the students to return home and we also have a graduation program. Even thou we are operating under our existing budget there have been a number of extra ordinary costs that were outside of the budget so all of our reserves have been depleted. To remedy this problem I am returning to America immediately to raise one time contributions to put the school back on solid footing and to find a sponsoring church for myself. I am asking all who receive this newsletter to ask your congregation or other congregations that you may know to give me an opportunity to present the work to them and ask for a one time contribution at this time. I will arrive in Los Angeles on June 4 and then travel to Morgantown WV on June 8, where I will pick up a vehicle and cell phone. At that time I will start calling all that I know to set up speaking engagements to raise the funds to cover this emergency. Please give your friends or relatives in other congregations a call and ask them to give me an opportunity to give a presentation to their mission committee, elders, or congregation. Thank you.
