At one dinner during the trip, we added the ages of the Myanmar 11 and were surprised to see it exceed 600 years. It was a senior missions all right. Victor and Ee Kai felt like kids amongst us oldies. I couldn't have asked for a better team or host (Samuel Thang). Boo Chye worked the hardest. Deacon Paul (aka fearless leader) ensure that every detail and need was taken of - before, during and after the trip. The two ladies (Nat and Ivy) had their share of work but everyone contributed tremendously in various ways. The team spirit was great and everyone was on time and ready to go.

I observed that Sam and his preacher father has started a N.T. movement in various parts of Myanmar.
