



The congregation at Sansai, Chiangmai, Thailand numbers about **50 members** from the village.



Most of the members are old folks, but there are a few younger people, like brother Urton who was at our church camp in 2006. While I was there, he was the only one who spoke English.

I invited his son, 'Film' for our 2007 camp, but his family has just moved into Chiangmai and was not able to join us. This year, the entire family wants to come; but under the camp standing guidelines, only 'Film' qualifies for his camp fees to be paid by the church. I believe it is important that PP trains and encourages young families such as this to nurture the aging congregation in Sansai. **If you would like to contribute to help bring this family to the PP camp**, please check with sister Nat what is needed.



As you can see the pillars for the church building on the spacious land that PP members have purchased are already up. I was told that the work for the roof has been awarded to a contractor and the congregation may move into the new location after completion.

The PP congregation has donated another \$5,000 (110,000 baht) this year. This will help them put up some walls and make the building more ready for occupancy.
