Jesus said, "When you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, and you will be blessed (Luke 14:13-14). He shared that this blessing comes from God because these guests were not be able to repay the host. Jesus approved of helping people who normally would not be invited to charity donations balls with prestigous social connections.



When we consider that Jesus spoke these words as He sat at a meal given by a Pharisee, His message seems provocative and radical. But truth love is radical in that love of giving to meet the needs of others without expecting anything in return. This is how Jesus has loved each of us.
