Today's scripture texts: Isaiah 63:7-9; Hebrews 2:10-18; Psalm 148
Isaiah 63:9 IN HIS LOVE AND PITY

Jesus Christ is with you in your misery. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego never realized the presence of the Son of God so blessedly until they were thrown alive into Nebuchadnezzar's burning furnace (Dan. 3:20). There, His presence was so manifest that even the heathen king exclaimed, "I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire; and they are not hurt, and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God." (Dan 3:25)

Many children do not receive special love while they are healthy, but when illness comes their mother's abundant love is poured on them. The Lord says to you who need comfort, "As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; and you shall be comforted." (Is. 66:13)

It was to His ancient people that God gave this gracious promise, "In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the Angel of His Presence saved them; in His love and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bore them and carried them all the days of old." (Is. 63:9) He still tenderly and lovingly deals with His tested and afflicted people. This thought should make you forget your poverty and misery.

Be of good courage weary pilgrim, for the years are flying fast and trials and troubles are flying just as fast. This world is, to the believer, like a country inn, where there are so many comings and goings that one cannot rest. Never mind. You are tarrying here only for one short night, and then you will be up and away to your eternal home.

During the most intense difficult time in my life I happened to see this poem on a secretary's desk, and it changed my life. Let me list it for you, just in the rare case you never read it.

One night I dreamed I was walking along the beach with the Lord. Many scenes from my life flashed across the sky.


In each scene I noticed footprints in the sand. Sometimes there were two sets of footprints, other times there was one only.

This bothered me because I noticed that during the low periods of my life, when I was suffering from anguish, sorrow or defeat, I could see only one set of footprints, so I said to the Lord,

You promised me Lord, that if I followed you, you would walk with me always. But I have noticed that during the most trying periods of my life there has only been one set of footprints in the sand. Why, when I needed you most, have you not been there for me?"





COVID-19 Preventive Measures

The leaders want to thank all the members for their cooperation and patience last Sunday in complying with the additional measures of temperature screening and no parking in the church premises. These and other measures like regular disinfecting of the church premises will continue until further notice. The leaders will continue to monitor the situation and update the church if there are changes. In the meantime, we advise members to continue practising good hygiene and remind those who are not feeling well, have a runny nose, cough or sore throat to stay home and not attend the church services.

For those who are worshipping at home, do note that there is a direct link to the live streaming of the worship services on the home page of the PPCOC website (ppcoc.org).

We thank God for His protection over us and ask that you continue to pray for the authorities as they manage this crisis, for the medical staff as they help and treat those affected and for everyone to stay calm and united in this fight against the spread of the COVID-19.

Temperature Screening Process

- 1) All members and visitors are to proceed to the Temperature Screening Station (TSS) at the church lobby before proceeding to the auditorium or other areas of the church premises.
- 2) At the TSS, after your temperature is taken, a sticker will be given, and you are to complete a simple declaration form.
- 3) Follow the signage for movements within the church premises to minimize contact between those who have their temperatures taken and those who have not.

Note for Drivers

- 1) There is **no parking** in the church premises with the exception of the handicapped who will park at the designated handicap lots.
- 2) Please park at the **Capricorn** and take the shuttle bus to/from the church premises.
- 3) There are 2 **drop-off points** – one in front of the church lobby and the other along the driveway with a drop-off sign to indicate the area. If unsure, follow the car marshal's direction.


Pray for Lucy Kwan's 92-year-old mother who is critically ill with lung infection and who is not yet a Christian.




