Online Mission Workshop: With A Demonstration by Winston at 9.30 AM

Text: 1 Corinthians 2:1-16; Isaiah 58:1-12; Psalm 112:1-10

In Isaiah's reading, we hear a compelling cry for righteousness and kindness - a valuable reminder that God's light shines no more brightly than when we serve humanity. Similar themes are echoed in the psalm's reading that light shines through the lives of the righteous. Here, too, righteous living is living committed to others. In the 1 Corinthians' reading, we hear Paul clarifying the nature and essence of his sharing as a missionary and a disciple maker, insisting that both derive their power from God and not from human sources.

Hence, the theme from the Old Testament reading and the psalm present the image of true followers of God as the means of God's manifestation. And in the epistle reading, Paul stresses that the power of his sharing comes in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.

Worship Theme: Consider Your Call by Peter Lim at 11 AM

Text: 1 Corinthians 1:18-31; Matthew 5:1-12; Psalm 15

This week, we get a glimpse into God's longings and the 'workings' of God's heart. God longs for us to know Him and be in an intimate relationship with God – as shown by Paul's reflection, Jesus' teaching, and by the Psalmist's question – all of which show us God's longing to be known by us (Corinthians), to bless us (Matthew), and to have us in God's presence (Psalm 15). What a loving source of life we have in God! Thus, I propose that Mission is a Function of Worship: We want to glorify God and share the love of God that we have received and experienced.

Church Wide Covid-19 updates

- i. The In-Person congregational worship service will allow up to 100 persons max every Sunday.
- ii. Regulations require us to be in two separate groups of 50 with no inter-mingling allowed. So, we will divide you into 2 groups Group A and Group B.
- iii. When you arrive each Sunday, take your temperature and register at the temperature taking station. We will tell you whether you belong to Group A or Group B.

Group A - proceed to the Auditorium level 2;

Group B - proceed to the Balcony at level 3.

iv. After worship, Group A in the auditorium, please exit by the back door next to the stage. Group B is to exit by the usual staircase in front.

Please do not mingle – instead, invite each other out in groups of 5 for fellowship.

i. If you intend to come for worship next Sunday, please continue to register and submit the registration form on the website for that Sunday. Submissions open on Monday, and the cut-off is on <u>Friday 12 noon</u>.

If the church carpark is full, you may park at Capricorn Science Park 2 but our shuttle bus service is not available – so we solicit the help of brothers and sisters who managed to park in the church building to give a lift to those who need to get to their car at Capricorn after worship.
