Theme 2021 – Rebuilding Our Faith

2020 has been an eventful and for some, a traumatic year brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic. The effects of the pandemic have resulted in hardship and losses, and even today, many are still struggling to cope with the new “normal”. Spiritually we have not been spared either. With the implementation of safe management measures and restrictions, the church was not able to meet and function as we normally do. While the long-term impact of such restrictions is still unknown, there are already signs that Christians have also been “battered” spiritually. Whatever is happening to us has caused some of us to waver in our faith and to question and doubt God’s presence and providence. There is possibly a slow and subtle decline in the attention and effort in spiritual matters: the pressing concerns of our physical needs have been prioritized ahead of our spiritual needs. Some may become unmotivated to read God’s word, to attend or even join in the online worship services and are indifferent to how they are spiritually.

That is why the leaders have chosen the following theme for 2021 – **“Rebuilding Our Faith”**.

We want to spend the new year that God has given to us to rebuild and strengthen our faith in our Almighty God. In our rebuilding project, there will be a need for a strong foundation to start off with. And brick by brick, the building will begin to take shape. Likewise, we will need to re-discover the foundation that our faith is based on – our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Brick by brick, through studying God’s word, working on our spiritual disciplines of prayer, worship and kingdom service and allowing the Holy Spirit to work in our lives, we will end the year stronger in our faith than when we started.

Therefore, we encourage each and every member to do this for 2021 to help rebuild their faith:

- Remember that our God is trustworthy and faithful (Hebrews 10:23).
- Remember to make time for God, His word and His people.



It has been said that the only thing that doesn’t require effort is growing old and everything else does. So it is with our spiritual lives. It will require us, with God’s help, to commit and make an effort to rebuild our faith in God. In line with the theme, there will be a series of sermons and bible lessons to help us in our efforts. 2021 is anticipated to be another challenging year, but our assurance is that our God has gone before us, is with us and will never forsake us.

Job's profound grief was evident in his response: he "tore his robe and shaved his head" (Job 1:20).

His words in those painful moments help me see Job's discipline of gratitude: he claimed God had given him everything he had lost (Job 1:21).

How else could he worship in the midst of such lamented grief? The practice of daily gratitude can ease the magnitude of pain we feel, in seasons of our loss.

Recognizing God's goodness to us — even in the smallest of ways — prepares us to kneel in worship before our All-Powerful God even in the 'darkest hours' of our earthly lives.

In moments like this, let's remember to acknowledge the faithfulness and goodness of God to gain strength and victory over the doubts and fears cast by the evil one!


