

#### NT Small Group Structure And Process

Two weeks ago, I began to encourage the heads of family and individuals to start a small group with the following steps:

- 1) "Prayer and fasting." This will secure the new group (so that we start "pregnant," ready to multiply in 12 months). Then we
- 2) "Invite along" members and friends. At the "information meeting," we talk about everything that being in the group will entail.
- 3) Right away, everyone commits to an understanding. This includes an awareness that we will be "maturing while multiplying", a key to future group multiplication.
- 4) Everyone agrees to work through the bible class lessons or sermon messages. This will fulfill the "learning" aspect in the small group.

Apart from the four "rhythms" listed above, there are three remaining, which involve face-to-face, life-on-life time together. The group may thus make the commitment to meet face-to-face while doing the following activities:

1. Meeting for a meal in the first month.
2. Serving the needy together in the subsequent month; and
3. Playing / hanging out together in the month after that.

With these monthly meetings, a hybrid of worship services in member's home, and seeing each other at church worship services on Sundays, the small groups can reflect the seven rhythms of a New Testament lifestyle (This is not another program or bible class but is about relating and applying life-giving principles and encouraging one another). I pray that this will provide a structure and process for small group. Please feel free to call me and discuss further.

**BATAM: YOUTH DEVELOPMENT TO CONTINUE A REGENERATION OF THE CHURCH  
2 TIMOTHY 2:2**



Besides evangelism and the development of women, one of our programs aims to equip youths to enable them to serve the church and expand it through evangelism in this great country of Indonesia. Forlandya, a graduate of Batam Bible College, is a young woman who started this ministry in 2014. She aims to develop the women in the mission fields like Sumatera, Java and Borneo to help them improve their role in the church in Indonesia. She has a zeal to travel to the mission field and stay for three to four months in an area.

While living with the brethren at each area she visits, she shares the Word of God with the women as well as with the youths and children. She actively builds good relationships with the people she meets to help them grow. All this time, PP Church of Christ in Singapore has been supporting her work through her travel costs to our missions to Sumatera and Java. (Borneo the great city is still fund raising)

In the midst of the pandemic Covid 19, Forlandya went from house to house to visit the youths in order to maintain physical distancing and avoid the crowds. The youths have been enthusiastic in searching the Word of God and in studying the book of Timothy, looking to the example of Timothy as a model for their lives. Forlandya has been using the book of Timothy to demonstrate the practical Christian life and to emphasize spiritual attributes such as humbleness, patience and integrity. She focuses on their relationship with God and His church as a light to the world. The youth have been really interested during the sharing sessions as it gives them hope about life ahead.



If any among of you are interested in supporting this ministry, we are seeking funds to help Forlandya travel to other areas in Indonesia to help the ladies and women in the mission field to improve of their role in the church. Her cost is US\$ 500 per trip, and we plan to have three trips each year. Thank you for your support, prayer and encouragement to us. Praise be to God and our Lord Jesus Christ who has opened the door so that His Gospel may be spread in Indonesia.
