An elder relates an experience of his visit to a church:

"I went to a church to worship a couple of weeks ago, a church I had never attended. I saw something when I walked into the worship auditorium that I've never seen before. It was so unique that it captured my attention immediately. I couldn't take my eyes off from it. What do you think it was?"

We tried to guess but failed. His answer: a box of Softess. Here was a church where it was permissible to cry. There aren't many churches that way. Most churches subtly, and some not-so subtly, say, "Don't cry." When you do, you generally feel uncomfortable.

Psalms 13 is a psalm of lament. Psalms of lament make us uncomfortable. They say things we aren't sure should even be said aloud. They get in touch with the pain inside of us that we're not always eager to engage.

We believe that Psalm 13 and other psalms of lament have been placed there by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, deliberately, thereby giving us permission to lament.

In-person Congregational Worship Service continues today. Members and visitors who intend to worship at the church premises on Sunday can walk in without registering in advance. Everyone must observe the Safe Management Measures such as temperature taking and checking in and out with SafeEntry.

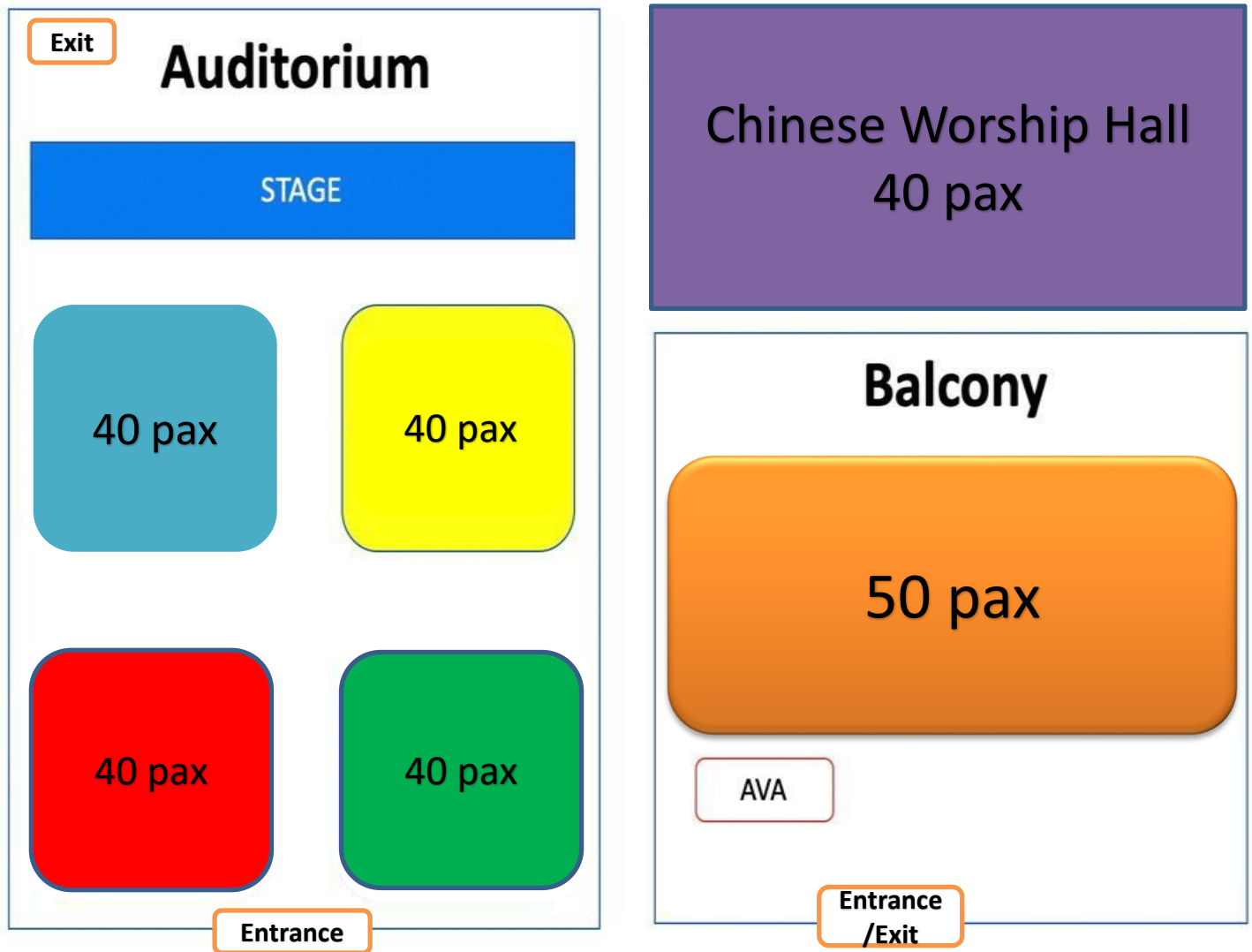
WELCOME BACK TO BIBLE CLASS!

4. The usher will give you the respective colored sticker for the chosen or assigned zone.
5. Kindly remain seated in your respective zone and do not move to another. **No mingling!**
6. Please remain seated and wait for the announcer to call your colour zone before leaving your seat.
7. Just a gentle reminder not to mingle after the service, as per safe management measures.

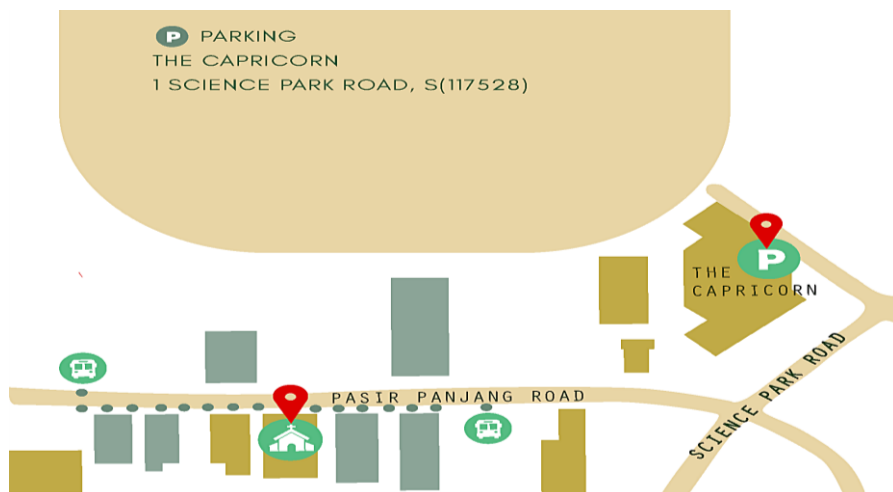
