According to The Cultural Atlas (www.culturalatlas.sbs.com.au), in group-centric cultures, such as Singapore, the family is the first group a person joins at birth. The interests of the family are expected to supersede those of the individual. Family members are expected to show loyalty to one another and receive preferential treatment over anyone else not in the group. Families also have a collective face. The act of an individual will impact the perception of the entire family by others.

Does this depict what our families are like in our country? Does it depict your family? Who shapes the culture that the family members live and grow up in?

As we continue with our focus on families, I would like us to ponder over these questions:

1 Peter 2:18-25

Our text falls clearly and neatly into two divisions. The first is verses 18-20 which focus on Christian servants who are called to suffer for Christ's sake. The second is verses 21-25 in which Peter turns to the Old Testament prophecy concerning the Lord Jesus as the Suffering Servant who provides the motivation, the means, and the model for all suffering servants.

Joshua 7-8

After Jericho, Israel is shocked to lose a battle against the smaller city of Ai.

When Joshua beseeches the Lord in prayer, He reveals sin in the camp—Israel had taken things devoted to Him from Jericho. Achan is identified as the guilty one and punished. With truth uncovered and relationship restored, Israel attacks again. This time Ai is defeated.



Through the anointing of oil, the Spirit of God fills the individual with divine power to perform their sacred role. We want to welcome John Lim to full-time

ministry in PPCOC after four years of training at Harding University. We want to publicly affirm the unique calling that God has placed on him.

On **4 July**, we will hold a special ceremony after the regular service to dedicate him to God and "anoint" him with the Holy Spirit. Let us celebrate together as one of our own answers to God's call to ministry!


Baptism of Jimmy Teo


A prayer about Discernment - Needing to know the right way to go.
