



According to The Cultural Atlas (www.culturalatlas.sbs.com.au), in group-centric cultures, such as Singapore, the family is the first group a person joins at birth. - How important is the father's role in the modern family?



1 Peter 2:18-25

Our text falls clearly and neatly into two divisions. The first is verses 18-20 which focus on Christian servants who are called to suffer for Christ's sake. The second is verses 21-25 in which Peter turns to the Old Testament prophecy concerning the Lord Jesus as the Suffering Servant who provides the motivation, the means, and the model for all suffering servants.

Joshua 7-8

After Jericho, Israel is shocked to lose a battle against the smaller city of Ai.

When Joshua beseeches the Lord in prayer, He reveals sin in the camp—Israel had taken things devoted to Him from Jericho. Achan is identified as the guilty one and punished. With truth uncovered and relationship restored, Israel attacks again. This time Ai is defeated.






