After a 2-month worship series on family topics, we will kick off a 4-week worship series on "What It Means to be Giving to God." This morning we begin with the topic "Real giving is trust in God on a deeper level."

In an emotionally-charged video that went viral, children from low-income backgrounds are presented with a gift for themselves and a gift for their parent. Then they were told they must choose between the two. Video maker Bob says 80 percent of the kids he interviewed, chose to give their parents a gift instead of keeping the toys they were offered.

Aaron, 9, is shown deliberating between keeping Minecraft Lego sets for himself or jewelry for his mother. It only takes a moment before Aaron gives his answer. "Legos don't matter," he says confidently in the video. "Your family matters—not Legos, not toys—your family. So, it's either family or Legos, and I choose family."

Don't you find it heart-warming when a child knows his priority? How innocent and pure is the heart of a child? When Christians exude such agape love, people are bound to be drawn to our community of faith.

Synopsis

In an age when biblical discipleship appears to be waning, four current and former church elders call for spiritual renewal through restoring the ancient faith, practices, and ethos of the first Christians.
