## A Minister's Musings

### Answering the Call | By John Lim



As I write this, it is Day 14 of my journey into full-time ministry. I suppose that like any new phase in life, my first couple of weeks were a total blur of activity. I'm just trying to figure out how things work, getting familiar with my new responsibilities, and learning to establish meaningful routines.

Everything about this feels so exciting and invigorating. All my life, I've felt like this was a call I was meant to answer—to love and serve people until they fall in love with Jesus. Everything I do, whether it's working with the Youth or preparing for worship and engaging with Scripture or curating Christian content for our Facebook page, brings me satisfaction that I cannot yet describe.

At the same time, there is also a gravity and seriousness to this role, and I am just starting to grasp the weight of it. More than the dayto-day duties of "prepare worship for Sunday" or "organize this Youth activity", ministry is about preparing souls for eternity.

It's a little overwhelming to think that virtually anything I do (or don't do) helps or hinders people from coming to Jesus. Every word I speak, every email I send, every step I take outside my house could be an avenue through which God blesses someone. I so desperately want to get it right because the stakes are eternal.

In the words of Martin Luther, "Here I stand; I can do no other." I am blessed to be able to enter a vocation where my gifts, passions, and ultimate calling meet together. There really is no higher cause worth living or dying for than the gospel of Jesus the Messiah.

What about you?

Do you see your life as a calling? Do you see your vocation as a potential avenue that God can use to bless others?

I think that full-time ministry gets labelled as a "calling" as opposed to secular "vocations". As though secular jobs are somehow outside of God's plan. As though they have no true purpose other than to put food on the table.

But I believe that God has "called" each of us to a unique role within His divine order. Paul describes the body of Christ as having many parts, each having its own unique function within the overall Life of the body.

Yes, God called some to be full-time prophets, teachers, and ministers. And we have a certain role to play. But God also called Joseph to be an administrator-manager in Potiphar's house. In the days after the Exodus, God called Bezalel the Artist to use his creative skills to design and build the Ark of the Covenant. God made David a politician to govern and rule his people. A *politician*!

And believe it or not, God called Ezekiel to just lie down on his side for 390 days! For the sleepyheads among us, wouldn't that be the greatest calling on earth! (What's more, right after he gets up, God essentially tells him "Actually, go back and lie down again for 40 days. Just do it on your other side.")

And *every single time*, God transforms their vocations into sacred callings. Joseph's administration saves the world from starvation. Bezalel's creative work becomes the literal dwelling place of God. David's reign is remembered not by his political or military success but by his radical faithfulness. Ezekiel, who had probably the strangest callings of all, used them to preach God's message in ways that stubborn Israel could finally hear.

Today, God has called accountants, lawyers, doctors, cleaning aunties, security guards, activists, civil servants, and every other career into his service.

And that includes you. Let that sink in.

God. Calls. You.

What does your calling look like? How can God use you to bless the world this week?
