### **COVID-19 Guidelines**

#### In short:

- You do not have to register for worship at our website.
- If you are **vaccinated**, you need to show proof when you come on Sunday (TraceTogether or Health Hub App, physical paper record, etc).
- If you are **not vaccinated**, you need a negative PET result from an accredited clinic no earlier than 12:30pm on Saturday.
- Children under 12 who are not vaccinated can still attend and do not need to go for PET.

### **COVID** Guidelines

The leadership welcomes the recent easing of safe management measures by the authorities, which allows more attendees for the inperson worship.

#### New Measures from 22 August 2021

- In-person congregational worship will be allowed up to a maximum of 500 persons (limited by church auditorium size) with the conditions shown below.
- All worshippers, religious and supporting workers are vaccinated\*.
- Divided into zones holding no more than 50 worshippers each.
- No crossing of zones allowed.
- All attendees are required to wear their masks.
- Singing will not be allowed during the in-person worship.

#### What qualifies as "vaccinated"?

- Fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the full regimen of Pfizer-BioNTech/Comirnatry, Moderna or WHO EUL vaccines, with an additional two weeks for the vaccine to be fully effective,
- recovered from COVID-19, or
- has obtained a negative result on a pre-event test (PET) taken in the past 24 hours before the expected end of the event. Note that this test has to be from an accredited clinic.
  - As children 12 years and below are ineligible for the National Vaccination, they are exempted from undergoing PET.

### **COVID** Guidelines

Procedures for attending in-person worship on Sunday

- There is no requirement to pre-register for the in-person worship.
- Please ensure that you are vaccinated (see previous page).
- For those who are not vaccinated, please ensure that you have completed the Pre-Event Testing (PET) no earlier than 24 hours prior to the end of the meeting. (Eg. Worship ends at 12.30pm on Sunday, test to be done after 12.30pm on Saturday). Please bring along the test result to the church for verification.
- Attendees will be seated in different zones.
- Kindly ensure that you check in and out via the Safe Entry Gateway.

We seek the cooperation of everyone attending the in-person worship to abide with the regulations and procedures for the health and safety of everyone. It is the leadership's prayer and desire that members will make the effort to worship together in-person.
