## TRUE LOVE

This week, I begin a new nugget theme: “True Love!” We start with this key question – “Do we truly love Jesus?”

Have we reflected if we truly love Jesus the way He wants us to? Jesus asked Peter if he loved Him and to “feed His sheep”. What was Jesus really asking of him?

"So when they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these [others do—with total commitment and devotion]?” He said to Him, “Yes, Lord; You know that I love You [with a deep, personal affection, as for a close friend].” Jesus said to him, “Feed My lambs.”

Again He said to him a second time, “Simon, son of John, do you love Me [with total commitment and devotion]?” He said to Him, “Yes, Lord; You know that I love You [with a deep, personal affection, as for a close friend].” Jesus said to him, “Shepherd My sheep.”

He said to him the third time, “Simon, son of John, do you love Me [with a deep, personal affection for Me, as for a close friend]?” Peter was grieved that He asked him the third time, “Do you [really] love Me [with a deep, personal affection, as for a close friend]?” And he said to Him, “Lord, You know everything; You know that I love You [with a deep, personal affection, as for a close friend].” Jesus said to him, “Feed My sheep”. John 21: 15-17 (AMP)

### Footnotes

- 1.John 21:15 As indicated by the amplifications, Peter uses a different Greek word for love (phileo) than Jesus does (agapao) in His first two questions to Peter (see note 2 on v 17).
- 2.John 21:17 This time Jesus uses the same word for love that Peter previously used twice (phileo).

Now we know that loving Jesus means keeping His commandments and doing what He says: feeding His sheep. We need to love Him even while He is gone, for the Holy Spirit, our Comforter, is with us now. Like Peter, we struggle not to deny Christ as our Shepherd and Lord. To feed His lost sheep, guide, care for, and protect them from harm is a daily challenge that needs true love as the answer to Jesus's question, "if we truly love Jesus, we are to feed His sheep".

## Reflection Questions:

1. What is true love?
2. Why do you think Peter uses a different Greek word for love (phileo) than Jesus does (agapao), to answer Jesus?
3. Are we loving God with a (phileo) love instead of the Father's (agapao) love? Why?

## Prayer:

Father and Lord, thank You for giving Your Son's life for us. What You've done for mankind is the greatest act of true love. We cherish what You've done to open the doors to salvation. We come willing to be washed of our sins daily. You are our Lord and King and we worship You. You have shown agapao love to us. Lord, you make this all possible so that all people can be blessed. We don't have to rely on our strength to love those we find it hard to love, for You are there to help us. Please continue to use us to bless others, with a giving heart driven by true love. May Your love go forth through us to touch many souls. In Christ's name we pray, Amen.
