Be still. Pause...wait, and listen to 'God's whisper.'

Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way, over the man who carries out evil devices! (Psalm 37:7)

I waited patiently for the Lord; he turned to me and heard my cry. (Psalm 40:1)

Our lives today are so fast-paced that we battle continual exhaustion, trying to keep up with never-ending demands. We're constantly stimulated by social media, advertising, school programs, church events, and our own inner clamor. This frantic pace is exhausting!

Wearing multiple hats can create a sense of importance, recognition, and self-worth. Yet, at the end of each day, a feeling of fatigue and even senselessness can creep over the 'self-importance' like weeds in an unkept garden.

Even our "Quiet Time" is anything but quiet, as we run through one task after another until we can check it off our list with satisfaction. Our bodies sit but our minds race, and the idea of stillness seems almost impossible. There's so much to do, and so little time. Surely God understands...right?

Learning to be still and quiet before the Lord is one of the greatest challenges we face today. Yet it is our quest to enter and experience true intimacy with Him.

Be still, quiet the clatter, and enter into God's stillness. Take time to read through and meditate on the following verses as you seek stillness and rest in God's presence.

And he said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat. (Mark 6:31)

"Martha, Martha," the Lord answered, "you are worried and upset about many things, but few things are needed—or indeed only one. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her." (Luke 10:41-42)

Instead of waiting for the perfect conditions to talk with the Lord or allowing myself to believe I need a 'special time' to enter into His presence, I remind myself to shut out both the inner and other noise and read out my Father's Words of life....

Be still. Pause... listen to God's voice...

Reflect And Respond

1. In what ways have we allowed the noise and normal busyness of life to keep us separated from God?

- 2. Are we driven by a list of daily tasks or are we spirit-driven?
- 3. Will we listen to God's gentle whisper?

Today, let go of the need for perfection, and just rest in His presence. Cut out the inner noise and listen to "sound of silence" in your own life. The work that God wants to do in us is always heart work. He has purposes and plans we cannot see or know.

Dear God, help us draw near to You. We know that whatever story You've written for our lives is beautiful because it's from You. Help us quiet the voices of the world and seek silence to hear Your gentle whisper and be filled with Your peace in our hearts today. In Jesus' Name we pray, Amen.
