Be still. Pause...wait, and listen to 'God's whisper'

"Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way, over the man who carries out evil devices." (Psalm 37:37)

Waiting is revealed throughout the Bible. It is a major spiritual discipline. Abraham waited for the promise of his son Isaac. In the middle of the wait, he faltered and Ishmael was the result.

Moses waited forty years for his ministry before delivering the Hebrews out of Egypt. Jesus waited until he was 30 before beginning his full-time ministry.

Many Psalm writers sang about waiting for the Lord. David wrote in Psalm 40:1, "I waited patiently for the Lord; he turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the pit of despair, out of the mud and the mire. He set my feet on solid ground and steadied me as I walked along."

The prophet Isaiah exhorts us in Isaiah 40:31 that those "who wait for the Lord, shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint."

The apostle Peter encouraged us to live in "holiness and godliness, waiting for and hastening the coming of the day of God... to wait for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells." (2 Pet 3:11-13)

Faith in God involves pause and waiting. Waiting and delay has been a challenge throughout my life. How about you? How often do you PAUSE and wait?

Actually, it does not matter how long the pause is. It is simply 'unbearable' for most of us because we have become so accustomed to getting instantaneous results for almost everything. Baby boomers, Generation X, Generation Y, Millennials - we all do not want to pause and wait. We get agitated when we do not get what we want instantly!

So, how can we learn to pause and wait? We want everything to be a lot faster. Our 'now' is about the urgent and immediate. As a consequence of our unwillingness to pause and wait, our attention span gets shorter, stress floods our minds, and the light of God's promises darkens. We do not think clearly. Emotional anxiety cripples our judgment. We are distraught by looking at the minutes and hours painfully ticking by.

Be still, sit down and let God fill in the pause.

"Pauses in Life" serve Different Purposes

1. Pause brings us peace in our "storms in life".

Our storms can be difficulties, loss of expectations, change, upheaval, war, disaster, hurt, disappointment and loneliness. Yet the Holy Spirit calls us to wait and trust in both seasons of pause and seasons of acceleration.

2. Pause is for refining and pruning.

Stand still to be pruned! Jesus tells us in John 15:2-4 "I am the true grapevine, and my Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch of mine that does not produce fruit, and he prunes the branches that do bear fruit so they will produce even more. You have already been pruned and purified by the message I have given you. Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful, unless you remain in me." Lean on God fully during times of pruning and refining. It's uncomfortable, even painful but it is good for us in the long-term.

3. Pause develops perseverance.

The Apostle Peter encouraged the early Christians and us in 2 Peter 1: 5-9, to make every effort to add to your faith, goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love. For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, we will be effective and productive in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Remember!

Pause refines our Christian character. Pause develops spiritual maturity. Pause builds intimacy with God. Pause is for deep soulful, spirit-filled worship. Pause empowers us for living life!

Do not delete the 'Pause'! It is there for renewal and refreshment. So don't skip your own pause... Take time out to ponder and reflect... Be still. Pause...wait and listen to God's voice.

Reflect and Respond

- 1. What 'pauses' are you encountering in your life?
- 2. Are you aware of the purpose of each 'pause'?
- 3. Ask, "God, what are you teaching me and showing me in this pause?"

Today, let go of the need for perfection, cut out the inner noise, and listen to our "pauses of life". Let God reveal to us His purposes and plans through each 'pause' of life.

Prayer

Dear God, help us draw near to You in each 'pause' to learn and listen to Your gentle whisper. Quieten the noises of the world as we pause for Your peace to fill our hearts today. In Jesus' Name we pray, Amen.
