Youth Retreat






We rejoice with Deepa and Naveen on the birth of their second child, Ezekiel. May the Lord continue to bless and keep this family.

Be a Transmitter of God's Glory

Paul's statement about boasting in the Lord has nothing to do with bragging about our worldly possessions or achievements. (1 Cor. 1:31)

Whatever 'success' we have attained in our work, be it at school or in our career, excellence in sports or life accomplishments, even our service in ministry, - "so neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God who gives the growth." (1 Cor. 3:7)

We have no reason to boast because, humanly speaking, we are "weak," "foolish," "lowly," and "sinful". All glory goes to God and God alone. The context of boasting centres on God manifesting His glory in our moments of strengths and weaknesses.

Three ways, we can boast in Jesus:-

- 1) Refrain from Comparing with Others.
- ". . . that none of you may be puffed up in favour of one against another." (1 Cor. 4:6)

It is common for parents in a conversation with others, to focus on their children's 'achievements'. There is often a tendency to compare and let others know that their child, or themselves have been awesome in performing a certain task.

But this is not the boasting Paul is referring to. Let the boasting be made in the name of the Lord! Proclaiming God as the Sovereign One who blesses our children or ourselves to become 'successful' in any of our undertakings.

So, let us learn to be mindful of others' compliments and use them as opportunities to boast about God's providential love and care for us.

2) Be Grateful for what the Lord God has blessed us with.

Tomorrow's tasks often cause us to worry. Anxiety is one of those things that robs us of our peace of mind! We have an endless capacity for worry. Anxiety clouds our memory! It robs us of contentment and peace.

Why does anxiety invade our peace even on the best of days? Because of forgetfulness! That God took care of us in the past, just as He takes care of us today, and will do so tomorrow! That is the evidence of the glory and power of God in the world.

3) Honestly and openly give Glory to God when the temptation to self-glorify comes our way.

"I am the Lord. That is my name. I will not give my glory to another; I will not let idols take the praise that should be mine." (Isaiah 42:8 NCV)

Our boasting of the Lord highlights His great attributes, what He has done for us, and what He is still doing and what He has promised to do.

The answer to boasting in the Lord is plain from all these texts:-

• He loves the heart that boasts in the Lord.

- He loves the heart that gives Him credit for what He alone can do.
- He loves the heart that relies on His power.
- He loves the heart that wants Him to receive the glory in all things and that wants the power of His Son to shine in our weakness.

As the beloved of God, we know that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope arises in concert with the love of God present in our heart by the power of the Holy Spirit. We boast in the hope of glory, and we boast in our afflictions.

"Therefore, as it is written, "Let him who boasts boast in the Lord." (1Cor. 1:31)

REFLECT AND RESPOND

- Make a list of our successes and give God glory!
- How can we give God glory even as we struggle?

PRAYER

Father, heal us from our self-dependency and self-glorification, so we can see and sense Your power, glory, and Sovereignty. May we desire to listen to Your whispers of truth and loving guidance, be mindful and live according to Your will and purpose for us. May Your love and peace fill our hearts today. To You, oh Lord, God be the Glory!

In Jesus' Name we pray, Amen.
