Our Appreciation to Minister Patrick Ong



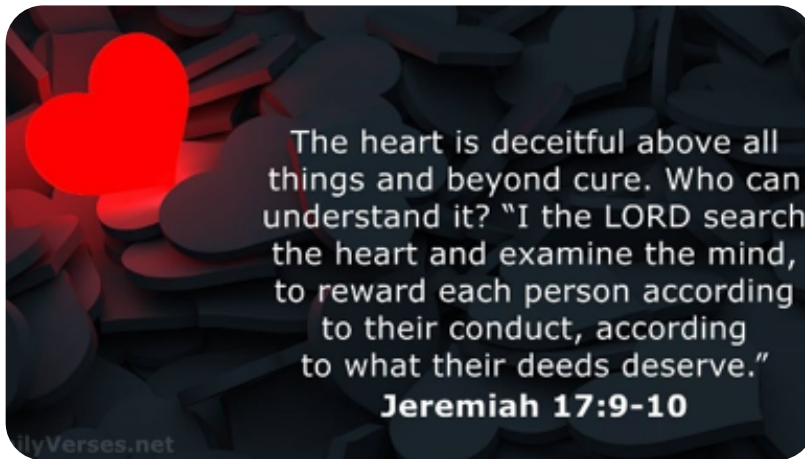

Take Great Care of Our Heart

This is what God says about the human heart. Yet He wants our hearts; our hearts' faith, our hearts' love and affection.

"The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it? I the Lord search the heart and examine the mind, to reward each person according to their conduct, according to what their deeds deserve." (Jer. 17:9-10)

A person may think their own ways are right, but the Lord weighs the heart.

"To do what is right and just is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice. Haughty eyes and a proud heart— the unplowed field of the wicked—produce sin." (Prov. 21:2-4)

"Those who trust in themselves are fools, but those who walk in wisdom are kept safe." (Prov. 28:26)

Which is more difficult? "Loving God" or reflecting on "God's Love" for us? Personally, loving God is more difficult as a human's needs and desires cry out more loudly than the 'Loving Voice of God'. God's Love is always shining brilliantly and flowing graciously no matter what we do. His love never waivers - it is the same yesterday, today and for eternity.

In life, we struggle with our mountain-top and valley-low moments in our "Love for Him". Our flesh is indeed weak! Ironically, our Love for Him is strongest when we are in our moments of greatest pain and deepest need. When we are in trouble and in despair, we tend to draw nearer to God.

Seriously reflect on the nature of our heart. "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it." (Prov. 4:23)

Salvation itself begins in our heart. "For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved." (Rom. 10:10)
