Accountability Holds the Team Together

"As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace." (1 Pet 4:10)

We live in a world that embraces personal freedom to do and act out our 'rights' without accountability to others. To combat this worldview, we need to discover and recover a love for reading God's Word and develop a desire to share that Word with others.

Jesus who knew the importance of teamwork, built a team of twelve apostles who worked humbly together to build the Kingdom of God as one dedicated team. Consider Philippians 2:3-8 where Paul calls us to have the humility of Christ, or John 13:3-5 when our Lord stooped to wash the dirty, mud-caked feet of His disciples.

1. Accountability requires humility to accept godly counsel

Often, we are blind-sided by the lures of this world, and it is our brothers and sisters-in-Christ who can help us see from God's vantage point. That is why we need input from others who are sincere and passionate about the Lord. (Prov 12:15).

2. Accountability builds up godly behaviour

Surround yourself with people who genuinely want the best for you. They are potent allies in your spiritual growth.

Life-giving accountability is not just about keeping records of sins and bad behaviour. It enables others to get close to us, to understand our temptations, triggers, and helps us navigate our lives towards positive and healthy ways, spurring one another towards good works (Heb 10:24).

3. Accountability keeps us sanctified

Accountability is not only for offering helpful advice but it is an opportunity to be more Christ-like (Eph 2:10). The journey of leadership can get lonely, difficult, and even burdensome. With 'cheerleaders' who are invested in us and our goals, it is much easier to keep going. They provide follow-up and encouragement to keep us on course, and they celebrate our achievements along the way!

4. Accountability builds perseverance

Maintaining passion and zeal in our faith is not easy. Many people start enthusiastically but fade over time. So, keep that passion alive by surrounding ourselves with others who share our enthusiasm, to maintain our fervour (Rom 12:11-12). We can lean on the passion of others and vice versa.

5. Consider having a godly accountability partner(s)

Accountability relationships are special and confidential. Find another brother or sister to share your values and passion for Jesus. Talk about what both of you expect from the accountability relationship. A note of caution: "Accountability partners" must be mature and responsible; they shouldn't end up gossiping or meddling.

Reflection, Prayer, and Meditation

- 1. Do you desire to grow into Christlikeness? Why, or why not?
- 2. Do you wish that God will send someone as your 'accountability partner' for Christ to spur you to good works?
- 3. Do you wish to serve God as an 'accountability partner'?
- 4. Do you need guidance and training?
- 5. Pray and offer to serve as a brother's or sister's keeper.

Prayer:

Eternal Father, grant us each a brother or a sister to be an encourager; a 'cheerleader' when life seems overwhelming and exhausting. May we not serve selfishly, for personal ambition or vain conceit. But help us lead with humility to serve one another. So, Father, raise us up as Your servant-leaders. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.
