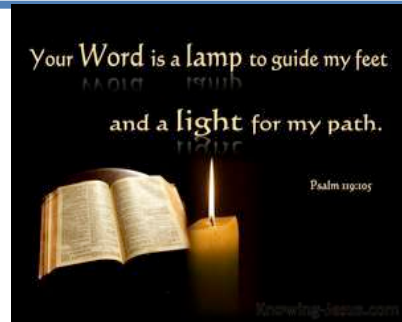
This is the first newsletter of the year from the FILIPINO and FRIENDS FELLOWSHIP, meeting at the Church of Christ in Pasir Panjang.
