




Ladies Reconnect

Colouring the Resurrection

One Sunday morning, I was standing behind a family with young children listening to the sermon. At one point, one of the children began waving a sheet of paper, proudly showing it off to his parents.



It was hard not to notice. It was a colouring sheet of the empty tomb – with the colours in rather odd places. Bright crayon lines streaked unevenly across the page, leaving the rocky tomb a mix of purple, orange and white gaps. Jesus turned water to wine; this child turned brown rocks into purple and orange!

At first I simply grinned at the delightful play of a child. What pure joy can be found in putting a crayon to paper and creating something that wasn't there before. We might not see such art hanging on a wall in a museum exhibition, but here is a child using colours with their own unique twist to bring a Bible story (in fact, the Bible story) to life. That is a beautiful thing.

Then it hit me: isn't this a beautiful analogy of Christian living for all of us, young and old?

In a sense, we are all spiritual children. We're trying to understand a God who surpasses understanding. Yet God in His mercy has given us a picture of indescribable grace and mercy. Jesus came to be a model for us to follow, a black-and-white outline that we fill with the colour of our own lives as we try to live as He did.

Minister's Musings

If we're honest, we usually make a mess. We don't "colour inside the lines" or use the right colours in the right places. We colour some parts so harshly that the page almost rips apart while other parts get left blank.

How often do we stray from the bounds that God has set in place for us? Don't we focus on some parts of our lives so much that we almost lose ourselves while completely ignoring other important parts?

But in the middle of the mess, by sheer divine grace, we also stumble upon something profoundly right. I don't know if the child who coloured the tomb in purple meant it, but purple is the colour of royalty and kingship.

Somehow, this child landed on an incredible truth. He crowned Jesus as King at His resurrection, covering the tomb with the best colour to represent His true royalty.

I don't think the point of our lives on earth is to get everything perfectly right, because we won't. Rather, I think it's about engaging with life as fully as we can, playing and experimenting and messing up, trusting that God will direct our paths, redeem our decisions, and make truth and beauty emerge from the mess we make.
