In Jesus' parable of the wedding feast, two things are immediately clear: first, it's important that you show up, and second, make sure you dress for the occasion. Again, it's a parable of the kingdom that invites us to consider our own responses to God's invitation. How are we going to RSVP? And what sort of "clothes" are we going to present ourselves in?

The kingdom life may not be convenient or even comfortable. It may seem much more appealing to stay home in our T-shirts and shorts and our regular rhythms of life. Yet surely, this is one wedding feast that we would not want to miss, and it will be worthwhile.



Directory Photos





Genesis Again

The Coming of the Holy Spirit and the Establishment of the Spirit-Led Church.

Isaiah spoke of the day when the Spirit would be "poured upon us from on high" (Isa 32:15). And in Isa 44:3, God promised: "I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour my Spirit upon your descendants, and my blessing on your offspring."

God also said: "Then they shall know that I am the Lord their God... when I pour out my Spirit upon the house of Israel" (Eze 39:28-29) and "it shall come to pass... that I will pour out my spirit on all flesh." (Joel 2:28)

Jesus also said, "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not behold Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you, and will be in you." (John 14:15-17)

On the Day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit appeared. This day is often called the "birthday of the church." The Spirit now lives in every believer. (Eph. 1:13-14; 2 Tim. 1:14)

Thanks to the Feast of Weeks, also known as the day of Pentecost, the Jews from across the known world were gathered in Jerusalem. Their presence symbolically reflected the church's mission of reaching out to all the world!

This is why the gift of tongues was manifested (Acts 2:3-4). These were real languages, as confirmed by what the multilingual audience heard in Peter's Sermon preached in their very own language (vv. 5-11).

Peter's evangelistic sermon included the fulfilment of the prophecy; the historicity of Christ's life, death, and resurrection; His authority as God incarnate (v.22); the sovereignty of God (v.23); and human responsibility for what had been done to God's Son (v.36).

Peter's words pierced their hearts and they questioned what they should do (v.37). Notice how the Holy Spirit moved Peter's message to cause the listeners to confront their sins. He told them to repent, turn to God, and be baptised so their sins would be forgiven (v. 38).

This promise is also for us and our children. It is for everyone our Lord God will choose, no matter where they live (v.39). Peter told them many other things and about 3000 believed his message and were baptised (vv. 40-41).

We find a number of key lessons from Acts 2:

- 1. Notice that their fellowship centred around good teaching, having communion, praying, and living their new life in Christ.
- 2.There was mutual commitment to meet each other's needs. Believers gave willingly to help each other. This support included material and financial aid to meet their daily needs.
- 3. They met daily, either in a formal place of worship, such as the temple courts, or in each other's homes.
- 4. They praised God for all His good gifts. And finally, although it's not stated directly, they enjoyed having fellowship with each other.

Note: This is the recipe that produces growth among believers. Also, the Holy Spirit is the very representation of Christ in the Spirit after His physical death on the cross!

Questions:

- Do we have an uncompromising allegiance to God's word, no matter what?
- Is our life an embodiment of the Holy Spirit and manifestation of what we believe about the Holy Spirit-inspired Word of God?
- How do we go about seeking guidance, comfort and counsel from the Holy Spirit?

Prayer:

Heavenly Father, may the world see us and catch a glimpse of the glorious salvation in Christ! Search us, O God, and know our hearts and thoughts are pure! And see if there be any grievous thoughts in us but lead us in the way everlasting. Let your steadfast love give us life and be overflowing with the sharing of Your love and salvation. Lord as we walk in the Spirit, grant us the spiritual strength and will to live our lives for Your glory. In Christ's name, we pray. Amen.
