Be One Another's Keeper

Then the LORD said to Cain, "Where is your brother Abel?" "I don't know," he replied. "Am I my brother's keeper?" (Gen 4:9)

The Hebrew word for "keeper" is "shamar" which means, "to keep, to attend to, to watch, to guard". It is the word used for taking care of a garden, a flock of sheep, or a herd of cattle. In the story above, Cain questioned whether he was to do the same for his own brother, whom he had just killed out of jealousy. Obviously, Cain was wrong.

What does this mean for us who have siblings in the flesh or in the faith? I believe that it means that we are to watch over them and attend to them like a shepherd keeps his sheep. Christians are to be the keepers of one another. Here are a few scriptures that speak on this point:

"For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love. "(Gal 5:13)

"Whoever claims to love God yet hates a brother or sister is a liar. For whoever does not love their brother and sister, whom they have seen, cannot love God, whom they have not seen. And He has given us this command: Anyone who loves God must also love their brother and sister." (1 John 4:20-21)

"Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ." (Gal 6:1-2)

Jesus summed it up best in Mark 12:31, "Love your neighbour as yourself".
