Objection process:

Elders and Deacons are biblical roles with scriptural qualifications. Any member with reason to believe that a nominated candidate for Elder or Deacon is unqualified for an office, should express such objection in writing based on scriptural reasons to the Elders by 16 Oct 2022, whereupon the Elders may review and decide upon the matter.

This is not required for Board nominees.

Election Process:

The final list of nominees for Elders, Deacons and Board will be published on 23 Oct 2022 along with Notice of AGM. Our AGM is planned for Saturday 12 Nov 2022 from 1pm – 5pm at Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel. AGM will be in-person and without online facility.

The appointment of each recommended candidate for Deacon and Board member shall be confirmed by a simple majority vote of the members present at the General Meeting including proxies. The appointment of each recommended candidate for Elder shall be confirmed by a majority vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at the General Meeting, including proxies.

Setting an Example

Before we try to convince others to follow Christ, we have to lay a foundation of our Christian examples that build the trust of how great and loving God is!

1. We are to be Consistent and Faithful in Service

Jesus said, "But it is not so among you; but whoever wishes to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wishes to be first among you must be slave of all. For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many." (Mark 10:42-45)

2. Like Timothy, be an Example to Others

In his first leadership role, Paul advised Timothy to lead by example, by demonstrating the type of behaviour he might hope to inspire in others despite his youth. (1 Tim 4:12)

3. Like Daniel, be an Example of Patience and Perseverance

Changing the minds of others or the culture of an entire organization takes time and patience. Consider Daniel's example of patience: he worked for a king who frequently made immoral decrees. Nevertheless, Daniel kept doing his job well, while also doing what was right for his beliefs in God.

In the end, Daniel's faith was vindicated in the incident with the lions (Daniel 6), and Daniel's boss ends up praising God. But it took patience and perseverance on Daniel's part.

4. Paul's Advice: Humility is the foundation to develop grace

Pride closes the door to spiritual growth. Humility is the key that opens the door of your life to more of God's grace. To the humble, God gives patience, and peace, and gentleness. The fruit of the Spirit grows in the soil of humility. Pride tears up the fabric of the unity of the Spirit.

"Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all. But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it." Ephesians 4:2-6

- 1. Think about someone who has earned your trust. How did he or she do it?
- 2.How would you like people to act or react towards your daily interactions with them?
- 3.Are we already a Christ-like example at home and at work? What do we need to do to make our influence count for Christ?
