As a man thinks, so is he

"Do not eat the bread of a man who is stingy; do not desire his delicacies, for he is like one who is inwardly calculating. "Eat and drink!" he says to you, but his heart is not with you." (Proverbs 23:6-7)

We are defined by our thoughts. Every action starts with a thought. Ultimately, it is what "a man thinks, so is he." What one says or does is not necessarily what one is thinking. A person can be courteous, even polite, but have contentious thoughts and sentiments.

If we don't have control over something we are THINKING about, then we cannot change our behaviour.

To have God's power in our life and work, we must hear and obey His voice to replace the carnal worldly thoughts running through our heads and minds! God speaks to you through His Holy Spirit via the Word of God.

God empowers us by His Holy Spirit. To be filled with fullness of His power, we must learn and be guided to move by the power of the Holy Spirit. To become like Jesus, you must think His thoughts, speak His words, and do His deeds. We are (1) what we think, (2) what we say, (3) and what we do!

Reflection:

1. Who do we 'listen' to as we go about our daily life?
2. What is the 'inner voice' telling you to do? Is that 'God's voice'?
3. List down some areas of your life that you are willing to seek God's guidance daily? And put it into action for the next 30 days!

Prayer:

Father, we need Your leading and empowerment. Keep working on us until we are submissive to Your will. May each day be a glorious new beginning of becoming more and more like Christ. As we seriously examine our lives before Your Word, cleansed by the blood of Christ, we submit to the control of Your Spirit. Shine Your light through our daily living and make us into conduits of Your blessings as we live, love, and serve others. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.
