Come Lord Jesus - December Worship Series



For thousands of years, the ancient people of God looked forward to the coming Messiah – the Chosen One who would make all things right.

As the prophet Isaiah longed for the coming Messiah, he spoke of him as a Light who would conquer the darkness, a Tree who would bear fruit, the Water who would bring life to dry lands, and a Child who would be God with us.

In this series, we meditate on how Isaiah paints four portraits of Jesus that connect the entire story of scripture from the Creation, to his Incarnation, and to the Revelation. This is the story within which we live.

Key Challenges for the 21st Century Church

Christianity is changing and adapting rapidly. We communicate, travel and do commerce in unprecedented ways. The proliferation of social and mass media has flooded the minds of Christians globally.

How we understand and react to these global changes greatly impact and erode our faith in God, especially as we consume worldly news and developments rather than rely on the Word of God.

In part 2 of this series, with God's help, I will take the liberty of love to share nuggets of past experiences, observations and learnings for us to reflect upon as a family who loves God and His Church.

Learning 3: Peer Pressure Impacts Our Faith

Becoming Jesus' followers, we are often challenged to make difficult choices. Will we put our spouses, parents, children, friends or bosses above Jesus?

Jesus demands His rightful place in our hearts. We are to love Him more than all people, possessions, and prestige. Yes, Scripture calls children to honour their parents (Ephesians 6:2) and parents to provide for their children (Ephesians 6:4; 1 Timothy 5:8). Jesus does not say "do not love" those other people—what He says is that we ought to love God above all of them.

Likewise, reflect on your personal faith in God - "Who sits in the throne of my heart?" If you are a second or third generation Christian, ask yourself: "Did I become a child of God because of my parents, siblings, or peers in church?"

Remember! Loving others is the second part of the Great Commandment. But the first part is to love God with everything we have (Matthew 22:34–40).

Christ must be loved supremely, above all else! If we are not willing to give up all earthly possessions or forsake earthly relations that hinder our walk with God, truly we have no relationship with God.

Learning 4: Be alert to anything that challenges our faith in God.

We live our lives through compartmentalised boxes. We chat with multiple people at a time, post fragments of our lives on social media, consume visual media in one window and sometimes read the Bible in another.

We risk fracturing our daily experiences into disconnected parts that wreak havoc on our spiritual integrity. "Integrity" is wholeness (integer = whole number). A life lived with integrity is one that is wholly integrated with the Lordship of Christ.

Personal spiritual integrity keeps the church strong and united. Churches today should be extra diligent to cultivate this. Consider the words in 1 Corinthians 12:26: "If one part [of the Body of Christ] suffers, every part suffers with it."

Practical Spiritual Disciplines to Counter Trends 3 & 4:

- Start the morning with God, read God's Word and start having a conversation with God! Wake up a little earlier than usual and open up your Bible and read.
- Journal. Write down thoughts and feelings triggered by the Scriptures. Write it down on paper or keep a digital record to remind yourself of God's love throughout the day. Follow up with a Bible study or daily devotional discussion on your own, or with a buddy, or a small group.

 Pray for God to be in Your presence daily. Praying at any time of the day is a good way to grow your relationship with God. Tell God what you are feeling and ask for help in any areas of your life. Prayer is a conversation between you and God - so be ready to tell Him anything.

Lord, God, we truly want to do Your will and fulfil Your purpose in our lives. Empower us to do so, for we love You with all our hearts. Indeed, Lord, your eyes run to and from throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose hearts are blameless towards You!
