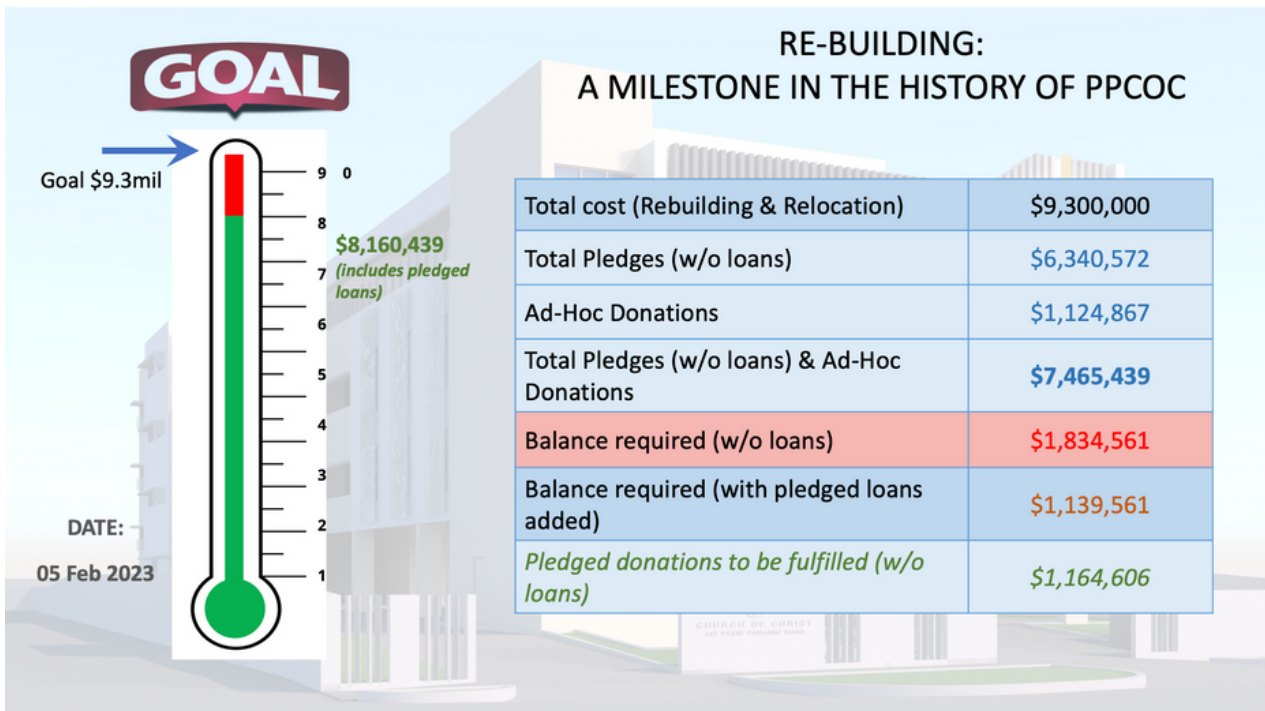

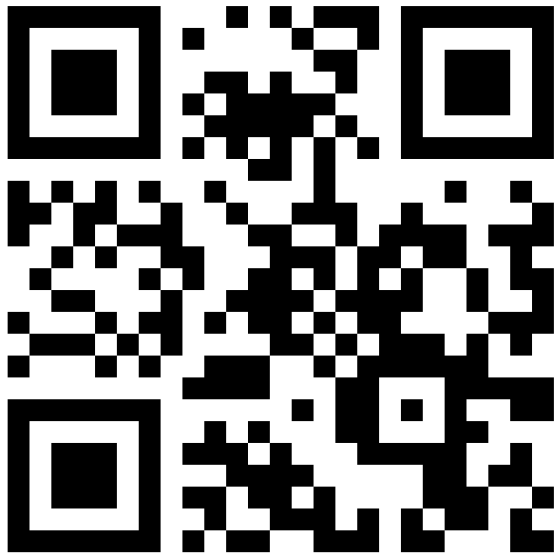

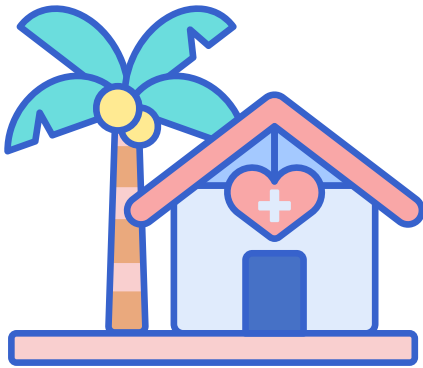
GEMS Teachers Workshop

Inter-Congregational Retreat 2023

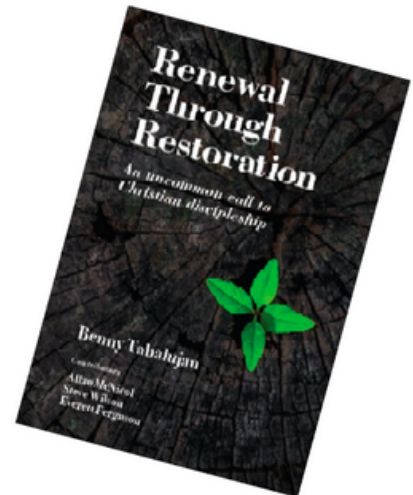
RENEWING DISCIPLESHIP

The theme for our 2023 Inter-congregational Retreat is discipleship. Our guest speaker, Benny Tabalujan, will be discussing how Christians today can experience renewal by restoring the faith, practices, and ethos of the first disciples.

Using a recent book authored by current and former church elders, Benny will ask questions like: According to Scripture, what is a disciple? What can the earliest disciples in the New Testament teach us about following Jesus today? How important is the Holy Spirit to discipleship? How can life among God's people – the church – help us become better disciples? If you're curious to explore biblical answers to these questions, come and join us at the retreat!



About the Speaker

Benny Tabalujan is one of the elders serving Belmore Road Church of Christ in suburban Melbourne, Australia. He previously worked in law firms, academia, and consulting in Australia, Hong Kong, and Singapore. He read economics and law at Monash University and gained a PhD in law from the University of Melbourne – where he continues to be a visiting fellow. Benny later obtained a Graduate Diploma of Divinity (Australian College of Theology) and a Master of Theology (University of Glasgow). Recent books he helped edit or author include: *Singapore Business Law* (9th ed., 2021); and *Renewal Through Restoration: An Uncommon Call to Christian Discipleship* (2021). He is also director of Klesis Institute (klesis.com.au), a ministry serving Churches of Christ in Australia and elsewhere. Benny and his wife, Pauline, have four children.
