The Anointed One Is The Royal Priest | 4 June 2023

Throughout this series, we've been exploring various aspects of "royal priesthood", which is one of Scripture's most common ways to describe who God's people are and what they do. We have seen that this royal priesthood is (1) God's image who (2) bless the world by (3) creating spaces for God's presence (4) as kings and queens.

Today marks our last week exploring this theme, and we see all of Scripture's imagery converge in a single human who perfectly fulfils every aspect of the royal and priestly calling. Jesus of Nazareth is the ultimate royal priest, and the good news is that He is for us.

But that's not all. Jesus not only serves as our royal priest for our benefit, but He also makes us royal priests for the benefit of the world. As Christ is, so have we become. It is our time to put on the royal crown and priestly ephod we were always designed for, and to image God to all the world.



Will the church provide travel insurance?

The church will NOT be providing travel insurance. Participants should purchase their own insurance before traveling.

I'm going to Malaysia by bus. Where and when do we meet?

Participants taking the bus to Malaysia are to meet at Marina South Pier MRT Station (NS28) Exit A. Please be there by 8am sharp.

I'm Singaporean. What paperwork must I complete to travel to Malaysia?

All participants (Singaporean and non-Singaporeans) must complete the Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) before traveling. Please refer to the link and QR code on page 4.

I'm non-Singaporean. What paperwork must I complete?

Please make sure you have your visas for traveling into Malaysia and Singapore on hand.

If you are returning to Singapore after the camp, you must complete the Singapore Arrival Card (SAC) before traveling. You may fill it up from Thursday, 15 June. Please use the link below or scan / click the QR Code.
