Today, their primary mission is to nurture disciples who live like Jesus, emphasizing love for family, faithfulness in marriage, care for children, and support for the local community.



Pacao & Tugas, Philippines Joemar & Annaliza Recomono

Joemar has been serving the churches in Pacao and Tugas since 2017, after completing his studies at SIBI Singapore. He and his family organise VBS and youth

fellowships in these communities, as well as home Bible studies throughout the countryside. He is involved in the community through teaching Bible and values at the local school, as well as serving with others in the local farmers' cooperative.

Singapore Gladioulus Place

Gladiolus Place (previously known as AG Home) is a non-profit residential Home for vulnerable teenage girls who are facing or are at risk of abuse, neglect,

delinquency, and wayward behaviours. GP aims to bring healing for their brokenness, renewal to their minds, and restoration to their families and communities as transformed individuals. Our partnership with GP started in 2016 through sister Lucy Kwan when they were seeking Christians to provide weekly devotions, tuition classes and recreation programs. Currently, we support them with fortnightly bible devotions, sponsorship of reading glasses, holiday outings (cycling, bowling, iceskating etc), study packs during exams and ad-hoc donations to their various programs. We currently have a team of 6 volunteers. If you can help to share devotions, conduct an art/craft workshop or tutor a subject, please let us know.
