Suffering for Reconciliation | 3 March 2024

Jesus once said, "Blessed are the peacemakers", which sounds like it'd be a really nice and pleasant thing to be. That is, until you realise that peace is 'made' where there was no peace before. Peacemakers are those who enter into dangerous and violent situations to bring reconciliation between two groups who usually don't want reconciliation. That's a recipe for suffering.

When Jesus calls us to be peacemakers, it's more than a call to be generally "nice people". It's a call to expose ourselves to danger and suffering for the sake of reconciliation. So the next time we get hurt while trying to do the right thing of bringing peace, that's a good sign that Jesus is working in us.
