"Death is just another path, one that we all must take," says Gandalf, the sagely wizard from "The Lord of the Rings". Of all the suffering known to humanity, death is the most universal and unavoidable. Wealth, popularity and virtue may allow one to escape most suffering, but the death of the physical body will come to all, however rich, popular or virtuous they are.



Return to 347: Week of Prayer and Fasting

On 31 March 2024, the PPCOC family will move into its new home at 347 Pasir Panjang Road. It marks the end of our two-year "wandering", a physical movement between venues and a spiritual journey of discernment.

Throughout history, God's people have marked significant occasions with a season of prayer and fasting. This was an opportunity for the entire community to be united in seeking God's Spirit, direction, guidance and blessing. Far from "earning" God's blessing by works-righteousness, prayer and fasting align the hearts of God's people to God's will.

For the week of 25-30 March, we invite PPCOC members to engage in special habits of prayer and fasting.

- We will send daily prayer prompts at 3:47pm each day, with a prompt to pray around one of our church values.
- We invite all members to "fast" on Friday. This may be from food for one meal (e.g. lunch or dinner) or a full day, depending on your ability.
 It may also be a fast from certain hobbies or habits, social media or screens, or anything else that you can give up for a day to spend time with God.
- In addition to Friday, you may choose to fast from those things for a longer period of time, e.g. doing a three-day fast from Wednesday to Friday.

We believe that this will be a powerful experience as we align our hearts together towards God and His will for us!



Because we are compassionate to others who come after us, we restore each venue we use to its right state.






GENERAL NOTES

A **shuttle bus** service between the Alpha and the church will run continuously from **9am to 1pm**.


ROOM LAYOUT

202: Alternative Seating Area (Family-Friendly)


204: Bible Class 1 205: Deaf Ministry

301: Auditorium Mezzanine 302-303: Bible Class 2 & 3 304-309: GEMS Classrooms



AUDITORIUM RULES



Food and drinks

Shoes

Hygiene

Furniture and Equipment

Handle furniture, equipment and appliances with care, and report any malfunctions and breakages promptly to the FAST team.



Labelling

Label all personal items to be placed in the refrigerator neatly and clearly with the stickers provided.

KITCHEN RULES (AFTER USE)



Clean up

Clean up the Kitchen and leave it in the same condition in which you found it.



Tidy up

Ensure that all items and equipment are kept in their designated places.



Switch Off After Use

Turn off the oven, microwave and stove, **BUT NOT the refrigerator.**



Personal Cutlery

Take your personal utensils, cutlery and appliances with you when you leave.
