Klesis Courses



Klesis is an organisation started by Benny and Pauline Tabalujan that seeks to "connect and equip Christians for God's glory" (from their website, <u>klesis.com.au</u>)

Among their many resources, they run online classes to equip members of the church with rigorous biblical and theological training. Instructors include familiar faces such as brothers Benny Tabalujan, Keith Gant and Evertt Huffard.

We are happy to announce that PP members who wish to be equipped through these courses will be subsidised by the church. Please take advantage of this for the upcoming class taught by brother Benny, titled "Christians and Careers: Integrating daily work into our walk of faith". How can Christians integrate jobs and careers into a life of faith?

If you're questioning the meaning of your job, this course is for you!

For many Christians, the best portion of our waking hours are spent at work. But how do we integrate work and career into our faith? In this course, Benny Tabalujan draws on more than three decades of experience as a lawyer, consultant, and educator to facilitate reflection on critical questions such as:

- Biblically, what is the purpose of work?
- Is the notion of a regular sabbath rest still relevant today?
- How do I juggle the demands of work, family, and church?
- Should a Christian be competitive and ambitious?
- Does God call me to a specific job or career?

The course will be delivered over four live online Zoom classes on Tuesday evenings. Each session includes time for seminar-style discussion, engaging with Scripture, and discussing practical applications. With relevant stories from the Bible and contemporary work culture, the course seeks to distil biblical principles which can be applied to working life today.

You'll also enjoy the exchange of ideas and lively banter with fellow believers committed to learning more about how daily work integrates into a life of faith.

He later obtained a Graduate Diploma in Divinity (Australian College of Theology) and a Master of Theology (University of Glasgow). Among the books he has edited or authored are: Renewal Through Restoration: An Uncommon Call to Christian Discipleship (2021) and God on Monday: Reflections on Christians @ Work (2nd ed. forthcoming 2024). Benny and his wife, Pauline, have four children.
