Gladiolus Place Fundraiser



Gladiolus Place is one of our local outreach partners that ministers to girls from difficult family backgrounds. They are organising a fundraising event called "Cycle Home" to fund family therapy sessions and family care packages.

We believe that the work they are doing is Restorative and in line with what God is doing in the world, and so we feel it is meaningful to support them.

The fundraising event is fully online. There are two parts to the event:

- (A) Pledging and raising of funds, either by yourself or from your friends. You can do this directly at their website, https://www.cyclehome.sg/ Once you reach your fund target, you will receive a free Cyclehome jersey.
- (B) The run/walk/cycle event, which will be tracked through Strava App. Instructions are as follows:
 - 1. Download Strava app and create an account.
 - 2. Register for Cyclehome account at https://www.cyclehome.sg/
 - 3. Register using same email as Strava app.
 - 4. Input fund pledge amount (minimum \$100)
 - 5. Input shirt size, and delivery address for the jersey should you qualify. (Shirt will be delivered 1 month after event ends.)
 - 6. For team, you can team up with friends and family.
 - 6. Select "PPCOC" for company
 - 7. Login and connect your Strava app to the CycleHome event.

CPR, First Aid and AED Training


