One of the most poignant scenes in the Lord of the Rings film trilogy is near the end, when the hero, Frodo Baggins, is too exhausted to continue his quest, even though he is almost at the end. His trusty companion, Sam Gamgee, equally exhausted, hungry and thirsty, sees the plight of his master and hoists him on his shoulders with a newfound strength, carrying him further than he ever thought possible. (Spoiler alert: they finish the quest!)

Even in our moments of weakness, when we think we have nothing left to give, seeing others with Jesus' eyes of compassion somehow unlocks hidden reserves of strength that we didn't know we had.
