Severe flooding has caused devastation in the regions of Vijayawada and Khammam, India (Near Guntur, home of brother Kiran). Many homes have been submerged, and hundreds of people remain trapped in floodwaters. The scale of the damage is far worse than reported, with countless heartbreaking stories emerging from those affected.
