




60th Anniversary: Celebration Activity

We will have many guests at these celebrations! Make it a point to catch up with old friends and make new friends over the meal.




We want our whole family to enjoy eating together, and not 'in our own rooms'. Please refrain from going to other venues, even if it's convenient to do so.

We are especially excited this year, as our leaders will be casting a fresh vision for our next decade as PPCOC!


