In the month of November, we are returning to our Witness series, where we invite leaders of the church to bear witness to the ways that God has been at work in their lives and the life of the church.

This Sunday, brother Danny Han preaches from Psalm 18, on how God graces us with what we need when we reach the end of ourselves. It's the gospel story of a God who came to save us when we couldn't save ourselves - and it's a story our culture doesn't like to hear. We like to think we're capable, self-motivated, and self-actualising. We can't depend on others for our success, and we have to depend on ourselves.

Shall we allow such a mentality, useful as it is in the secular world, to seep in to our faith? Shall we allow ourselves to burn out from trying to meet God's 'impossible' demands? Or is there a better way to live - by the grace of God?

Kyle on Work Trip

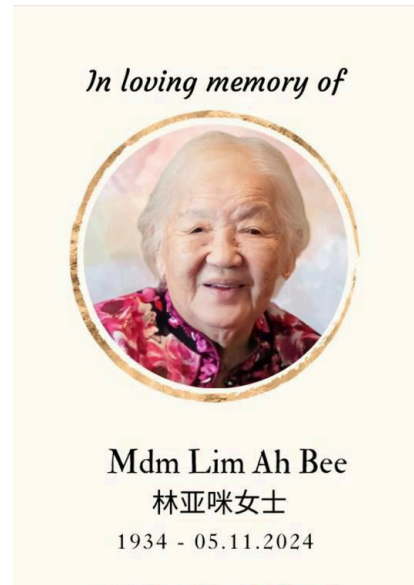
