Recap: TTSH Visitation



On the afternoon of 25 January, a team of 14 PPCOC members conducted an outreach visitation at Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH). The visitation encompassed four wards, reaching a total of 125 patients.

During the visits, the team distributed festive gifts including oranges and hand towels to the patients. To lift spirits and spread joy, the group performed both spiritual songs of encouragement and Chinese New Year songs. The team also had the privilege of praying with 43 of the visited patients.

This outreach strongly exemplified two of our church's core values:



Compassionate: Through personal visits, gift-giving, and songs, the team demonstrated Christ's love by bringing comfort and cheer to patients during their hospital stay, particularly meaningful during the festive season.

Restorative: The spiritual songs and prayers offered brought hope and emotional support to patients in their healing journey, contributing to their overall well-being beyond just physical recovery.
