PPCOC Church Camp 2025 Registration Guidelines

Church of Christ, Pasir Panjang, Singapore 27th Annual Church Camp 2025 Date: 18 to 21 June 2025

Venue: DoubleTree Hotel, Malacca, West Malaysia

1. Camp fees for participants are as follows:

Working Participants (Including NSF)	\$350
Non-working Participants / Youth / Domestic Helper / Retirees	\$250
Child (4 to 12 years) without bed	\$110
Child (4 to 12 years) with bed	\$228
Single Room (subject to availability)	\$610
Non-PP Member and Visitors	\$450

2. Please note the following for registration and payment:

- a. Registration will start from 2 March 2025 and ends on 6 April 2025.
- b. As the hotel has given us a fixed number of rooms, confirmation will be upon payment (first come-first served).
- c. Early bird discount of \$10/person (register with full payment by 16 March 2359hrs). No exceptions made. (Child rate No Early Bird Discount).
- d. Registration will be via online. The registration team will be at the church lobby on Sundays to assist with the online registration if required:

- e. All campers to note that 6 months passport validity from 18 Jun 25 is required for travel to Malaysia.
- f. Full payment is required by **6 April 2025**.
- g. Members who require financial assistance may approach the Registration Team.
- h. Accommodation will be assured for participants who register by 6 April 2025.
- i. Registration after 6 April 2025 will be accepted on a case-by-case basis, and accommodation is not guaranteed, as hotel rooms may not be available.
- j. Single rooms (without church subsidies) are available though not recommended and these are limited and subject to overall rooms' availability.
- k. Cancellations made by 6 April 2025 will be entitled to a full camp fees refund, but cancellation thereafter will not be entitled to a refund as payment would have been made to the hotel.
- i. Participants who opted to travel by the church bus to and from the camp are to inform their cancellation by 20 Apr or else will need to pay a cancellation fee of \$50.

3. Please note the following for rooming:

- a. Rooming will be on a minimum twin-sharing basis for adults.
- b. Preference will be given to members who have indicated their preferred roommate, based on a mutual agreement between the parties.
- c. Allocation will be done at the discretion of the committee if preference for a roommate is not indicated.
- d. Children aged 12 years old and below will be required to room with at least 2 adults.
- e. Youths may be required to share rooms on a triple-sharing basis; the designated youth leader will handle the arrangements for youth rooming.

We appreciate your understanding and co-operation in the administrative process and look forward to enjoying the time together at the church camp.

Please help us keep our carpark safe and welcoming for everyone:



Klesis Class: New Offering


