Prepare for Our Annual Retreat: Fast and Pray



In the story of the Bible, when God told His people that He was about to act, the people would prepare and "consecrate" themselves in prayer and fasting. We think about Moses commanding the Israelites to prepare themselves to receive the Ten Commandments at Mount Sinai, or Joshua preparing to cross the Jordan River.

In the same way, we invite you to prepare for Retreat through prayer and fasting! On the week leading up to Retreat, we invite everyone (whether you're attending retreat or not) to fast from something to prepare to receive God's revelation. It could be fasting from food or a specific kind of food, from a certain activity, a particular habit, basically something that you can give to God and say "God, I empty myself of this thing; fill me with your Spirit and will."

We pray this will be a meaningful exercise for you!


Host an Overseas Guest for Church Camp

Please help us keep our carpark safe and welcoming for everyone:


